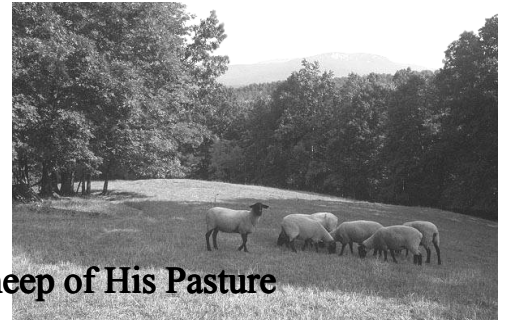

"Jesus Reigns!"

God promised David that his family would have a lasting royal dynasty. The prophet Nathan said, "When your days are over and you rest with your ancestors, I will raise up your offspring to succeed you, your own flesh and blood...and I will establish the throne of his kingdom forever" (2 Sam. 7:12-13 NIV).

God kept that promise to David by setting Solomon on the throne after him, and Rehoboam after him, and Abijah after him, etc. However, many of David's royal descendants sinned. Four-hundred years after David, Jehoiachin came to the throne. God's patience had run out. And so after having reigned only three months, God allowed King Nebuchadnezzar to carry Jehoiachin captive to Babylon (2 Kings 24:8-17). While David's faithfulness had brought God's blessings on his house, Jehoiachin's wickedness brought God's curse upon his house. The prophet Jeremiah said, "Is this man Jehoiachin a despised, broken pot, an object no one wants? Why will he and his children be hurled out, cast into a land they do not know? O land, land, land, hear the world of the LORD! This is what the LORD says: 'Record this man as if childless, a man who will not prosper in his lifetime, for none of his offspring will prosper, none will sit on the throne of David or rule anymore in Judah'" (Jer. 22:28-30 NIV).

What is so troubling about God's curse on Jehoiachin's descendants is that Jesus is one of them (Matt. 1:1, 11). The great question is this: How could God keep his promise to David (that he would have an everlasting, royal dynasty) and his curse upon Jehoiachin (that none of his descendants would again reign on the throne in Judah) at the same time? The answer is seen in how Jesus presently reigns. After Jesus' resurrection, he ascended to heaven and took his seat upon David's throne at God's right hand (Acts 2:29-36). Thus God has kept his promise to David in that his descendant is reigning (Heb. 1:5; Rom. 1:3), but he has also kept the curse upon Jehoiachin in that Jesus is reigning from the heavenly Zion and not the earthly one (1 Pet. 3:22; Heb. 12:22).

The application of this is that Jesus now reigns over all! He doesn't just reign over the Jews in Jerusalem. Rather, "the LORD has established his throne in heaven, and his kingdom rules over all" (Psa. 103:19 NIV). May we all bow the knee to King Jesus and not just tip the hat to him (Phil 2:9-11).
