

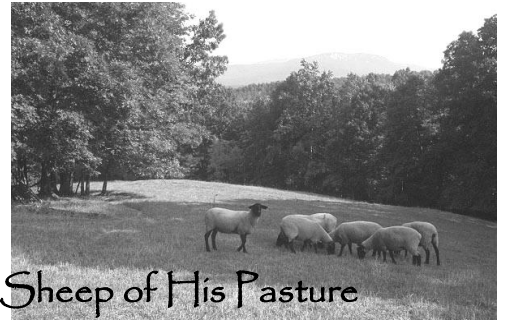

## "God's Protection"

God made an amazing promise to his faithful remnant while discussing Judah's captivity in Babylon; he said, "When you walk through the fire, you will not be burned; the flames will not set you ablaze" (Isa. 43:2 NIV).

Nebuchadnezzar, the Babylonian king, used the fires of the furnace to execute Jews with whom he was displeased. Jeremiah warned, "Because of them, all the exiles from Judah who are in Babylon will use this curse: 'May the LORD treat you like Zedekiah and Ahab, whom the king of Babylon burned in the fire'" (Jer. 29:22 NIV). Zedekiah and Ahab were Jewish, false prophets (v. 21). Clearly the promise made through Isaiah wasn't for wicked Jews.

However, we know of another story preserved by the prophet Daniel. When Daniel's three friends--Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego--refused to bow to the golden image that Nebuchadnezzar had set up, they were thrown into a furnace which had been made especially hot. But when invited by Nebuchadnezzar, "Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego came out of the fire...the fire had not harmed their bodies, nor was a hair of their heads singed; their robes were not scorched, and there was no smell of fire on them" (vv. 26-27 NIV). God had kept his promise made about one-hundred years before by Isaiah.

We have a similar promise made through Paul. He wrote, "The Lord will rescue me from every evil attack and will bring me safely to his heavenly kingdom" (2 Tim. 4:18 NIV). Paul wrote this on the eve of his execution via beheading. For this reason, the promise can't be taken as an assurance of protection from physical perils. However, it does clearly promise that God will protect his faithful people from all of Satan's spiritual attacks and that our souls will be brought safely into the eternal kingdom.
