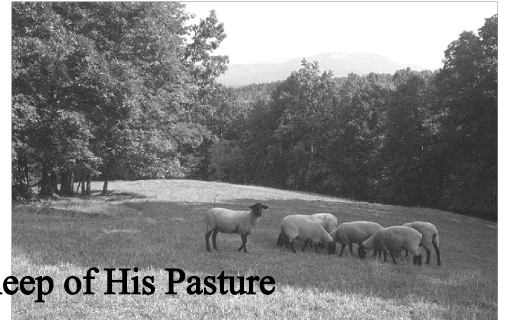

## "Vacation Bible School"

Timothy was very probably the closest person to Paul on this earth, and there was no one whom Paul considered to be a more valuable co-worker in the gospel than he. When writing to the Philippians Paul said of Timothy, "I have no one else like him, who will show genuine concern for your welfare...You know that [he] has proved himself, because as a son with his father he has served with me in the work of the gospel" (2:20, 22 NIV). Paul may have been the person who taught Timothy the gospel and baptized him (1 Tim. 1:2; 6:12), but the seeds for his faith were laid in his childhood by his mother and grandmother.

The apostle said to Timothy, "I am reminded of your sincere faith, which first lived in your grandmother Lois and in your mother Eunice and, I am persuaded, now lives in you also" (2 Tim. 1:4-5 NIV). Paul went on to remark, "But as for you, continue in what you have learned and have become convinced of, because you know those from whom you learned it, and how from infancy you have known the Holy Scriptures, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus" (2 Tim. 3:15 NIV). As Lois and Eunice were teaching little Timmy the books of the Old Testament and the song of the Judges, they were sowing seeds which yielded a great harvest in his lifetime by making him the servant of Christ that he was, and which would yield an eternal harvest.

Meadow View has just completed another VBS. There were a lot of people who invested a lot of time and energy into it. Rest assured that all of that energy will pay off.

Only eternity will be able to tell the value that this effort will have on making the children faithful servants of Christ. God said through Isaiah, "So is my word that goes out from my mouth: It will not return to me empty, but will accomplish what I desire and achieve the purpose for which I sent it" (55:11 NIV). To everyone who participated in this year's VBS by planning, donating food, decorating, teaching or supporting it by your presence and/or your prayers--well done!
