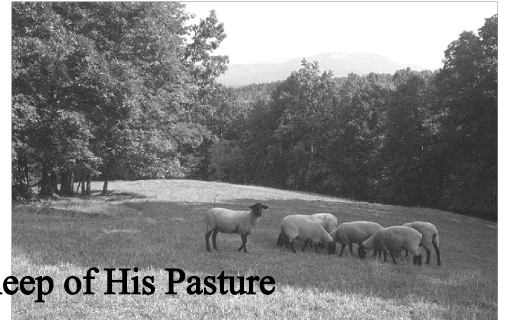

"Religion Unhealthy?"

Some people complain that religion is what makes people sick, with its emphasis on moral standards, guilt, sin, and the need for forgiveness.

Actually, some of the healthiest practices known to man are part of authentic Christianity.

1. Attendance - One study indicated that 20 yr. olds who attended worship lived (on the average) 7 years longer than the non-attendees.
2. PRAYER - A study in 2005 indicated that religious groups suffered fewer heart attacks if someone prayed for them.
3. GIVERS - The "Longevity Project" discovered that helping others lengthened life.
4. GRATITUDE - The people who write thank-you notes report fewer physical problems and sleep better.
5. BODY AS TEMPLE - Mormon men live almost 10 years longer than the general population because they don't use alcohol, drugs, or tobacco.
6. LOVING GOD - Having a punishing God vs. a loving God makes one recover more slowly.

These are good, healthy things you can be exposed to and "catch" at church!
