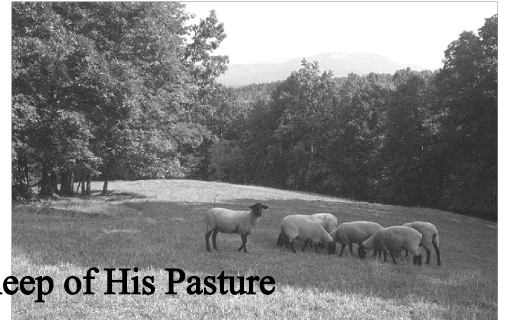

## "Our Merciful God"

The most supremely good, loving and merciful being in the whole of reality is God. When God revealed himself to Moses, he declared, "The LORD, the LORD, the compassionate and gracious God, slow to anger, abounding in love and faithfulness, maintaining love to thousands, and forgiving wickedness, rebellion and sin. Yet he does not leave the guilty unpunished; he punishes the children and their children for the sin of the parents to the third and fourth generation" (Exod. 34:6-7 NIV).

Moses anticipated the monarchy of Israel, and gave instructions to the future king in Deuteronomy 17. Verses 18 and 19 say, "When he takes the throne of his kingdom, he is to write for himself on a scroll a copy of this law, taken from that of the Levitical priests. It is to be with him, and he is to read it all the days of his life so that he may learn to revere the LORD his God and follow carefully all the words of this law and these decrees" (NIV). Presumably, since David was generally faithful to God's law (2 Chron. 6:16), he made for himself a copy of Moses' law--including Exodus (cf. Mark 12:26)--when he assumed the throne and regularly read from it. Therefore, David was familiar with God's declaration of himself as gracious to Moses in Exodus 34.

David's familiarity with Exodus 34 is also clear from David's own inspired writings in the Psalms. Psalm 86 is ascribed to David. He wrote there, "But you, Lord, are a compassionate and gracious God, slow to anger, abounding in love and faithfulness" (v. 15 NIV). One can hear God's words to Moses echoed by David.

The king's theology was not merely something that he preached on Sabbath, it was something that affected his living. When David sinned in taking a census, God offered him his choice of three potential punishments. Two of David's choices were either three months of being pursued by a human enemy or three days of a plague from God. David replied, "Let me fall into the hands of the LORD, for his mercy is very great; but do not let me fall into human hands" (1 Chron. 21:13 NIV).

An unnamed psalmist wrote, "If you, LORD, kept a record of sins, LORD, who could stand? But with you there is forgiveness, so that we can, with reverence, serve you" (Psa. 130:3-4 NIV). May we respond to God's merciful love with love for God and mercy toward others!
