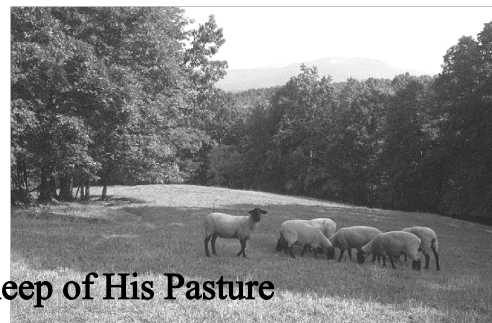

"Jesus Moved"

Three buddies were discussing death, and one of them asked the others, "What would you like people to say about you at your funeral?"

One said, "I would like them to say about me, 'He was a great humanitarian, who cared about his community.'"

The second said, "I want them to say, 'He was a great husband and father, who was an example for many to follow.'"

The third guy said, "I want them to say, 'Look! He's moving!'"

Jesus moved after death. He is alive today. He said, "I am the Living One; I was dead, and now look, I am alive forever and ever! And I hold the keys of death and Hades" (Revelation 1:18 NIV).

Because Jesus "moved" and now lives, we too ultimately will live.

"But Christ has indeed been raised from the dead, the firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep. For since death came through a man, the resurrection of the dead comes also through a man. For as in Adam all die, so in Christ all will be made alive. But each in turn: Christ, the firstfruits; then, when he comes, those who belong to him." (1 Corinthians 15:20-22 NIV).
