

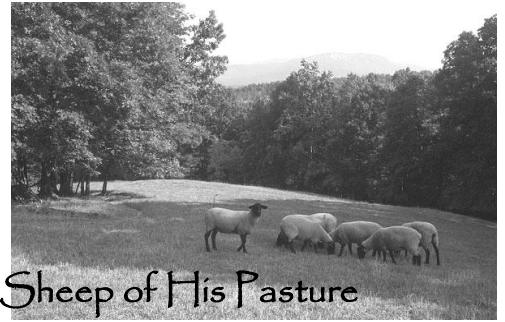

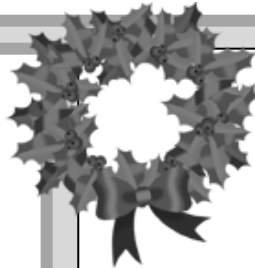

"Would You Trade for an Alligator?"

Fernando Cagnet Aguilera of Miami, Florida, walked into a convenience store on December 10 and tried to exchange a 4-foot-long alligator for a 12-pack of beer. The whole incident was caught on a surveillance camera. The store clerk refused to make the trade and called the police instead. Could you imagine making a trade for an alligator that would eventually grow large enough and ferocious enough to kill you?

Satan is just like Mr. Aguilera. He comes and offers to make us a trade--sin for our holiness. The sin may seem exotic and exciting at first, but, if it is not forsaken, it will grow large enough to destroy us. James says it like this: "When tempted, no one should say, 'God is tempting me.' for God cannot be tempted by evil, nor does he tempt anyone; but each person is tempted when they are dragged away by their own evil desire and enticed. Then, after desire has conceived, it gives birth to sin; and sin, when it is full-grown, gives birth to death. Don't be deceived, my dear brothers and sisters" (James 1:13-16 NIV).

Though it seems unlikely that anyone will ever approach you and try to trade you an alligator, it is a certain fact that Satan will approach you regularly to trade you a sin. When he does, follow the example of the store clerk, say 'no' and call upon the Authorities in prayer (Matt. 6:13). James promises, "Resist the devil, and he will flee from you" (James 4:7 NIV).
