

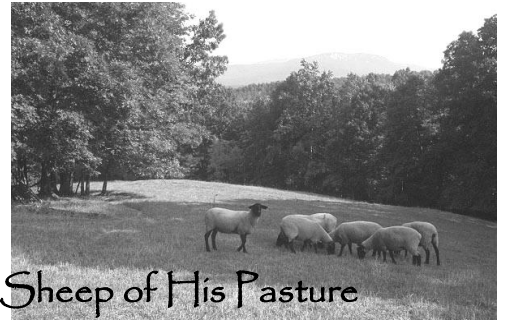

## "A Life Model For All To See"

Chris Rosati is a father of two girls who lives in Durham, North Carolina. There's nothing unusual about that.

Nothing is "usual" about Chris Rosati. He has been diagnosed with ALS, or Lou Gehrig's disease that cripples and then kills.

He made a decision of what to do with the remainder of his life. In his words, "he wants to spread as much kindness as I can as long as I can." And he has. Last year, he "hijacked" a delivery truck (with the permission of Krispy Kreme Donuts) and gave 1000 donuts to children in local elementary schools.

He says of his life, "I cannot give every lesson to my kids, but I can be a good person, and they can see that." Every day he gets up and looks to make new memories.

So what do his kids say? "He tries to make friends with the world."

It doesn't take power, prestige or fame to move the world. It takes someone who, whether able to walk on legs or move a joystick to maneuver a wheelchair, to show kindness to all they meet. If all you do in life is to show God's kindness to the world, you will succeed at living.
