

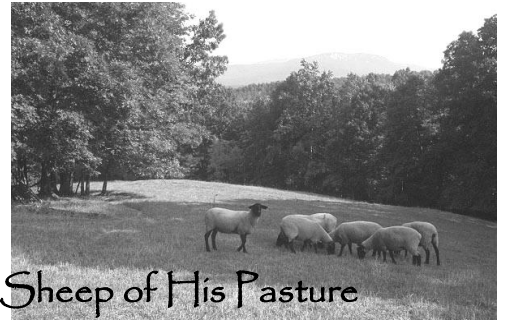

"An Instructive Reply"

The night of Jesus' arrest, he was carried to be tried by the High Priest of the Jews, Caiaphas. Caiaphas struggled to find two witness who could agree on a charge against Jesus because the Mosaic Law forbade a conviction from occurring upon the testimony of only one witness (Deut. 19:15). When no two witnesses could be found whose testimony agreed, Caiaphas finally asked Jesus directly, "Are you the Messiah, the Son of the Blessed One?" (Mark 14:61 NIV). Jesus, though often silent as a lamb before its shearers (Isa. 53:7), chose to answer that question. He replied, "I am...And you will see the Son of Man sitting at the right hand of the Mighty One and coming on the clouds of heaven" (Mark 14:62 NIV). Jesus' answer is pregnant with meaning.

(1) Jesus answers the High Priest's question by combining three Old Testament prophecies. "You will see" is an allusion of Zechariah 12:10 where the prophet pictures Jesus' saying to those who crucified him, "They will look on me, the one they have pierced" (NIV). "The Son of Man...coming on the clouds of heaven" is from Daniel 7:13-14 which describes "one like a son of man" ascending with the clouds to God (NIV). "Sitting at the right hand of the Mighty One" expresses David's words in Psalm 110:1; "The Lord says to my lord: 'Sit at my right hand until I make your enemies a footstool for your feet'" (NIV).

(2) Jesus clearly believed that the Old Testament was the product of God. Only God knows the future (Isa. 41:22-23). Jesus believed that the Old Testament foretold his ministry and passion (Mark 14:21, 27, 49). Therefore, he believed that it was the product of God's guidance and not merely man's guessing. Interestingly enough, Jesus believed that three Old Testament prophets, Zechariah, Daniel and David, though living at different times, all spoke of the same thing, namely himself (John 5:39). Therefore, Jesus viewed a common divine mind to be behind the prophets' own minds so that they were all inspired to write the same message (Mark 12:36).

(3) Jesus shows us that it is appropriate to find common themes that run through multiple books of the Bible that were written by different prophets, and that it is appropriate to seek to harmonize the messages of Biblical books into a unified whole. Jesus took statements that were made by three Old Testament prophets, sought and found their harmony, and put them together so that their common message could be heard in a single sentence. Jesus is a model for us in Biblical interpretation.

(4) Jesus was a man of the Bible. He was so familiar with Scripture and so full of Scripture and even at a time as stressful as his own trial, Scripture was rolling off of his tongue.

May we all learn from Jesus' instructive reply and "go and do likewise."
