

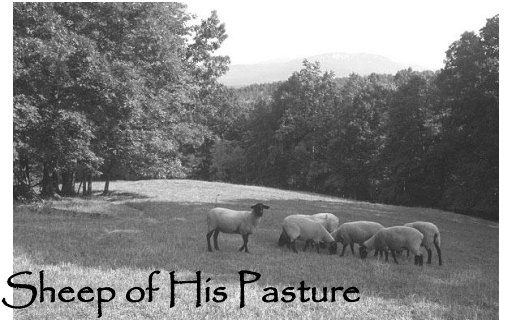

" Bearing the Yoke in Youth "

After Jerusalem's destruction by the Babylonians, Jeremiah sat in its ashes, wept and wrote Lamentations. He said, "It is good for a man to bear the yoke while he is young" (Lam. 3:27 NIV).

The yoke was a symbol that Jeremiah had used in his preaching for captivity to Babylon. In fact, God commanded Jeremiah, "Make a yoke out of straps and crossbars and put it on your neck" (Jer. 27:2 NIV). A few months later, a false prophet named Hananiah broke Jeremiah's yoke (Jer. 28:10). The weeping prophet was inspired by God to command Judah and other nations willingly to submit themselves to Nebuchadnezzar's yoke (27:8).

Why would Jeremiah say that it is good to bear that yoke while one is young? The false prophets were claiming that the captivity of King Jehoiakin and the temple articles would last no more than two years (Jer. 28:3). Jeremiah opposed that message of false hope (Jer. 28:15). He insisted, rather, that the captivity would last 70 years (Jer. 25:12; 29:10), that is, throughout the reigns of Nebuchadnezzar, "his son and his grandson" (27:7 NIV).

Jeremiah's message, though not as hopeful as the false prophet's, wasn't hopeless. He wrote, "This what the LORD says: 'When seventy years are completed for Babylon, I will come to you and fulfill my good promise to bring you back to this place. For I know the plans I have for you,' declares the LORD, 'plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future'" (Jer. 29:10-11 NIV).

If a Jew were carried to Babylon during childhood, they could survive the 70 years of captivity and live to see Cyrus' decree allowing them to return to Jerusalem (Ezra 1:1-3). Daniel was one such person. He was carried to Babylon when he was a young man. After Babylon's fall to the Persians, he read his copy of Jeremiah's letter (Jer. 29:1-23), and knew that the 70 year captivity was almost over (Dan. 9:1-3). He lived to see the return of the Jews from Babylon (Dan. 1:21).

The point is this. Though God is a Father who disciplines his children, he does so with grace. There is hope even in his discipline. "For no one is cast off by the Lord forever. Though he brings grief, he will show compassion, so great is his unfailing love. For he does not willingly bring affliction or grief to anyone" (Lam. 3:31-33 NIV).
