

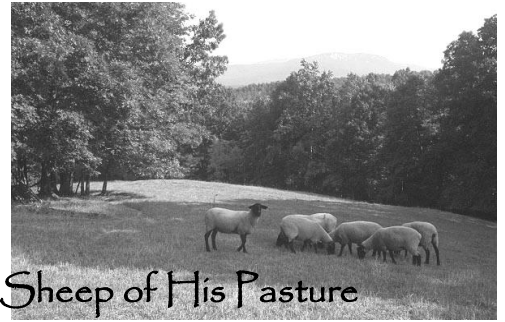

" August 3, 1492 "

A dusty 500-year-old calendar bears the obscure date of August 3, 1492. There are no poems written to jog the memory of the day. No holidays commemorate it. Few textbooks mention it.

However, if you sang a children's song you would know the outcome:

*In fourteen hundred ninety-two
Columbus sailed the ocean blue.*

The date is only significant because August 3, 1492 was the day three ships left Palos, Spain for India. Instead, America got in the way of Columbus' destination.

On August 3, 1492, the maps stopped where Columbus started his voyage. Ancient cartographers wrote in the margins a simple phrase in Latin which read:

Beyond this, there are dragons.

The horizon of our vision limits our lives. We only live what we know and experience. We have hope in the future, but no knowledge. In fact, the future stands both as exciting and fearful.

What does your future hold? Will success and fortune grace your life or will disease debilitate it? Will joy or sorrow walk beside you? Things unknown tend to unnerve us.

No human knows the future. We sing a song with a simple and profound refrain, "God holds the future in his hands." We all are like Columbus with sails snapped tight by the winds of circumstance headed into the future. With faith, we give the wheel over to the God, who knows the way.

We all live the day of August 3, 1492, but God's guiding hand erases the phrase, "beyond this there are dragons."
