

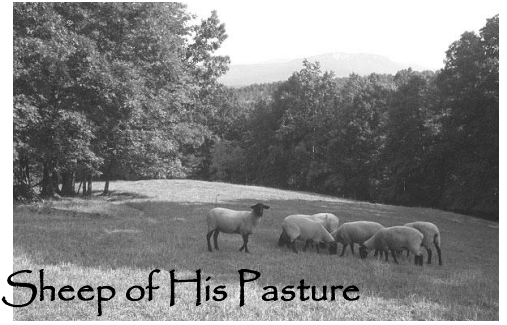

So he said, "if your right eye causes you to sin, tear it out and throw it away. For it better that you lose one of your members than that your whole body be thrown into hell...and cut off the hand that causes you to sin."

Think it over. How much is heaven worth to you? You need to shed anything that makes you unable to get through the gate.
