

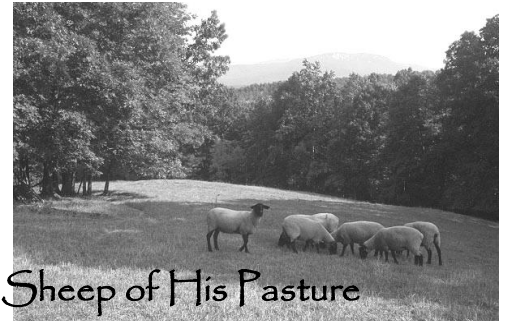

## "A Mediator"

The Book of Job describes Job's strong belief that God had turned against him. God had not turned on Job. God allowed Job to suffer, not because he was angry at Job, but because he believed in Job.

Job felt that he had no chance in trying to persuade God of his innocence. He said, "How can I dispute with him? How can I find words to argue with him? Though I were innocent, I could not answer him; I could only plead with my Judge for mercy. Even if I summoned him and he responded, I do not believe he would give me a hearing. He would crush me with a storm and multiply my wounds for no reason. He would not let me catch my breath but would overwhelm me with misery" (Job 9:14-18 NIV). Job went on to express this longing: "If only there were someone to mediate between us, someone to bring us together, someone to remove God's rod from me, so that his terror would frighten me no more" (Job 9:33-34 NIV).

What Job longed for so intensely, we have in Jesus. Paul declared, "For there is one God and one mediator between God and mankind, the man Christ Jesus, who gave himself as a ransom for all people" (1 Tim. 2:5-6 NIV). As the God-man, Jesus can bring sinful men and the holy God together. Through his death on the cross, he can satisfy God's wrath and thus turn God's punishing rod from mankind. Through that same death on the cross, Jesus could be a proof of God's love to man and so turn sinful man from his wicked ways. Thus the God-man, Jesus, reconciles God to man and he reconciles man to God.

Aren't you thankful to live on this side of the cross? What Job longed for, we must give thanks for. We don't have to cry out, "If only there were a mediator between us and God!" We can say, "Thank God that Jesus has mediated between us and God!"
