" I'm Free!?"

Bruce Jenner has completed his transition into a woman. The current issue of Vanity Fair features Jenner on the cover, no longer as Bruce, but now as Caitlyn. He remarked that with the publication of Vanity Fair, "I'm free." In an interview promoting his upcoming docu-series called "I Am Cait" which follows his sex-change, he remarked, "I'm the new normal."

The media demands that all applaud Jenner's actions as brave. They will tolerate no one who questions what he has done. Fox News' Neil Cavuto said, "Bruce Jenner is now Caitlyn Jenner. What...is going on?!" He was quickly attacked as "an old pasty white guy who just doesn't get it."

The truth is that God alone has the power to define what is normal. People should ask if God has given people the freedom to transition from one sex to another.

God has made both genders according to his will, as Genesis 1:27 says, "male and female he created them" (NIV). Since God makes people in their mothers' wombs (Psa. 139:13-16; Jer. 1:5), and since God makes every aspect of their being according to his will (Exod. 4:11), then every person comes forth at birth with the gender that God wants them to have.

God has given no one the right to confuse their gender. Moses wrote, "A woman must not wear men's clothing, nor a man wear women's clothing, for the LORD your God detests anyone who does this" (Deut. 22:5 NIV). Though some of the details of interpretation of 1 Corinthians 11:2-16 are debatable, one clear teaching of the passage is the distinction of the genders. "Does not the very nature of things teach you that if a man has long hair, it is a disgrace to him, but that if a woman has long hair, it is her glory? For long hair is given to her as a covering" (verses 14-15; cf. Rev. 9:8).

Isaiah's woe to the nation of Judah is very appropriate for the United States at this time. "Woe to those who call evil good and good evil, who put darkness for light and light for darkness, who put bitter for sweet and sweet for bitter" (5:20 NIV).
