

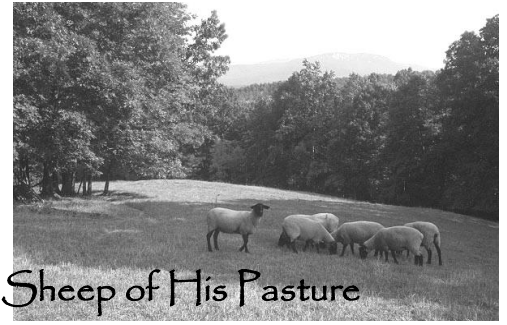

" OUR GOD-BREATHED BIBLE "

Paul wrote, "All Scripture is God-breathed" (2 Tim. 3:16 NIV). Paul considered both the books of the Old Testament and those of the New Testament to be Scripture (1 Tim. 5:18). To what extent is Scripture God-breathed?

It is God-breathed to the extent that its words are from God. Jesus was questioned by his Jewish opponents on the last Tuesday before his crucifixion. After he had answered all of their questions, he asked them a question concerning the sonship of Messiah. He then said, "How is it then that David, speaking by the Spirit, calls him 'Lord'? For he says, 'The Lord said to my Lord: Sit at my right hand until I put your enemies under your feet.' If then David calls him 'Lord,' how can he be his son?" (Matt. 22:43-45 NIV). Here Jesus argument rests upon one word--the word 'my.' Clearly Jesus believed that the Holy Spirit gave David the very words that he wrote.

It is God-breathed to the extent that the number (that is, whether a word is singular or plural) of every word is from God. Paul argued that the promises made to Abraham are inherited through faith in the gospel rather than through works of the Mosaic Law in Galatians 3. He wrote, "The promises were spoken to Abraham and to his seed. Scripture does not say 'and to seeds,' meaning many people, but 'and to your seed,' meaning one person, who is Christ" (v. 16 NIV). Here Paul rests his argument upon the singular word 'seed' in passages like Genesis 12:7. He believed that the Holy Spirit had inspired the form of the words found in Scripture.

It is God-breathed to the extent that the letters and diacritical marks on letters are from God. Jesus introduced one section of the Sermon on the Mount with this: "For truly I tell you, until heaven and earth disappear, not the smallest letter, not the least stroke of the pen, will by any means disappear from the Law until everything is accomplished" (Matt. 5:18 NIV). "The smallest letter" translates "iota," the smallest letter of the Greek alphabet, and probably means "yod," the smallest letter of the Hebrew alphabet in which the Old Testament was written. "The least stroke of a pen" translates a Greek word meaning "horn," which probably refers to the small marks that differentiate one Hebrew letter from another. Jesus believed that God had inspired the tiniest details of Scripture.

When we read our Bibles, there is a very real sense in which we are hearing God's voice.
