

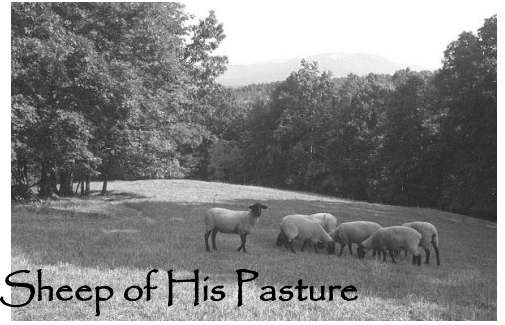

## " Your Load Limit? "

The question in our society used to be, "How can I go to heaven?"  
The new hot question is, "How can I get through this day?"

So what's the problem? Studies suggest that the American nation consumes about 20,000 tons of aspirin per year! In the early 1900's, the top 10 killers in America were all infectious diseases. By 1980 it was estimated that the new 10 killers are all stress-related diseases.

What's going on? Apparently we are such busy people that our load has shaken every facet of our lives.

The old adage about the "straw that broke the camel's back" suggest that when we have filled our lives too full, we don't have room for the smallest addition to our load. The straw does not weigh much, but if it is really the "last straw", added on top of a heavy load, it may make us collapse!

Perhaps you have noticed that bridges have a sign on them. The sign tells how much load that bridge can bear. Does that mean that if your vehicle weights 10 ounces more than the limit, that the bridge will be destroyed? Probably not, but it does suggest danger lurks close by if you exceed the limit.

What about your life? A simple modern poem catches the drama of our age:

*"This is the age of the half-read page,  
the quick hash and the mad dash.  
This is the age of the bright night with the nerves tight,  
And the plane hop with a brief stop.  
This is the age of the lamp tan in a short span.  
The brain strain and the heart pain  
with the catnaps till the spring snaps  
And the fun's done."*

Jesus suggested that we "not be anxious" about hurrying to the future and borrowing trouble. Instead he says tomorrow will worry about itself, because each day has enough trouble of its own." (See Matthew 6:25ff)
