

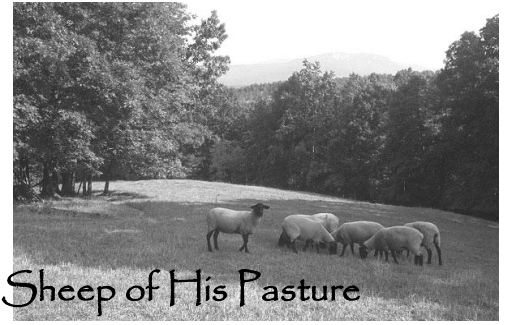

" Those Were the Days! "

Back in the 1970s "All in the Family" was one of the most popular sitcoms on television. Each episode began with Archie and Edith Bunker sitting at their piano and singing of the good old days. The final words that they sung were: "Those were the days!"

Our nation is changing fast (and not for the better). Last week's Supreme Court ruling which pronounced so-called "gay marriage" as constitutional may have us feeling like Archie and Edith. We may also miss the times that have gone by and feel that they were so much better than today.

The former days of our nation's history may well have been better than today, but they weren't perfect. Humans have the tendency to idealize the past. However, Solomon warned, "Do not say, 'Why were the old days better than these?' For it is not wise to ask such questions" (Eccl. 7:10 NIV).

Our nation has always had legalized sin in one form or another. In fact that sin has often been very heinous in nature. Remember that slavery was once legal, and it was not the same type of slavery that Moses legislated among the Israelites. It was the type that Paul condemned in 1 Timothy 1:10. As bad as I believe the Supreme Court's ruling is relative to "gay marriage," I still believe that its decision on January 22, 1973 that legalized abortion is far worse. As a result of the Roe v. Wade decision over 50 million babies have been murdered in their mother's wombs. God hates the "hands that shed innocent blood" (Prov. 6:17 NIV).

I am very saddened by the Supreme Court's ruling. We must remember that God brought judgment on Sodom and Gomorrah, in part, because of the sin of homosexuality; and God doesn't change (Heb. 13:8). However, we shouldn't think that this decision suddenly transforms us from a holy nation into a sinful one. It simply adds to our sin. May we all pray that God will give our nation time to repent (cf. Gen. 15:16), and may we all be salt and light (Matt. 5:13-16).
