

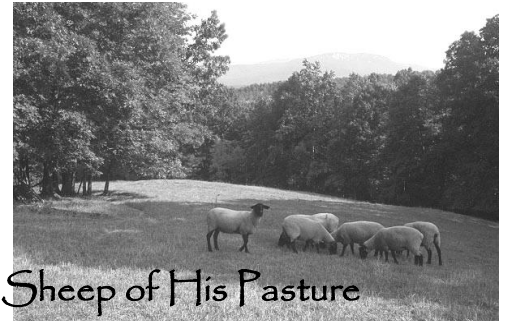

" A Good Conscience "

God says that he "forms the human spirit within a person" (Zech. 12:1 NIV). The human spirit has the ability to reflect on itself and judge its own thoughts and actions. Solomon wrote, "The human spirit is the lamp of the LORD that sheds light on one's inmost being" (Prov. 20:27 NIV). This aspect of the spirit is what we call the conscience.

The conscience of a person sits in judgment on both the actions of that person and the actions of others. Paul wrote, "Now this is our boast: Our conscience testifies that we have conducted ourselves in the world, and especially in our relations with you, with integrity and godly sincerity" (2 Cor. 1:12 NIV); and, "On the contrary, by setting forth the truth plainly we commend ourselves to everyone's conscience in the sight of God" (2 Cor. 4:2 NIV).

It is important not to violate one's conscience. Paul said, "So I strive always to keep my conscience clear before God and man" (Acts 24:16 NIV). In fact, willfully violating one's conscience by doing something that one's conscience says is wrong, even if the behavior is otherwise moral, is sin (Rom. 14:23). However, just because one's conscience approves of them, that fact alone doesn't mean that they are right with God. Paul again said, "My conscience is clear, but that does not make me innocent. It is the Lord who judges me" (1 Cor. 4:4 NIV).

Some people have such tender consciences that they feel guilty even though they are innocent. John said, "If our hearts condemn us, we know that God is greater than our hearts, and he knows everything" (1 John 3:20 NIV). Others, however, have hardened their consciences so that they feel innocent even though they are guilty. Paul described some false teachers with these words: "Such teachings come through hypocritical liars, whose consciences have been seared as with a hot iron" (1 Tim. 4:2 NIV).

Paul left Timothy behind in Ephesus as he traveled farther. He said that the goal of Timothy's work was that the Christians have "love, which comes from a pure heart, and a good conscience and a sincere faith" (1 Tim. 1:5 NIV). May we all strive to have good consciences!
