

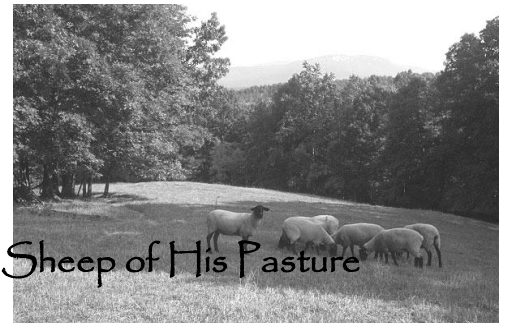

## " THE DEATH OF THE UNIVERSE "

Professor Simon Driver with the Galaxy And Mass  
Assembly (GAMA) project declared on Monday at an  
international astronomical meeting, "The universe is  
slowly dying." This pronouncement was made after an  
unprecedented study of 200,000 galaxies using the  
most powerful telescopes in the world, as well as those  
that NASA operates in space. Scientists looked at the  
energy output of those galaxies across 21 wavelengths  
from ultraviolet to infrared, and concluded that the  
universe is burning out.

This finding comes as no surprise to Bible readers.  
The Hebrews' writer quoted Psalm 102:25-27 in the  
process of proving the supremacy of Jesus. He wrote,  
"In the beginning, Lord, you laid the foundations of the  
earth, and the heavens are the work of your hands.  
They will perish, but you remain; they will all wear out  
like a garment. You will roll them up like a robe; like a  
garment they will be changed. But you remain the  
same, and your years will never end" (Heb. 1:10-12  
NIV). Note that he points to the universe wearing out  
like a garment. All material creation has been  
subjected to decay since man's fall into sin (Rom.  
8:19-23). GAMA's overall conclusion is just what we  
would expect.

Every so often sensationalists pick up on things like  
the pronouncement of the GAMA project and declare  
that a doomsday scenario is right around the corner.  
Christians need not imitate Chicken Little. Jesus told  
us plainly that the universe will come to a catastrophic  
end (Matt. 24:35). However, Jesus is the one who will  
destroy it at his coming. Peter wrote, "But the day of  
the Lord will come like a thief. The heavens will  
disappear with a roar; the elements will be destroyed  
by fire, and the earth and everything done in it will be  
laid bare" (2 Pet. 3:10 NIV).
