

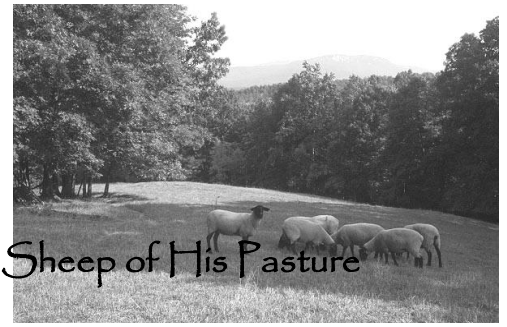

## " Are You A Prostitute? "

Entitling an article as this one has been is a surefire way to get people to read the article. However, the question given in the title is a serious question which we all should ponder.

The question is not: Have you been guilty of the act that is illegal in all states except for Nevada? Rather the question is based upon a couple of Old Testament passages written by Moses. Exodus 34:15 reads, "Be careful not to make a treaty with those who live in the land; for when they prostitute themselves to their gods and sacrifice to them, they will invite you and you will eat their sacrifices" (NIV). Numbers 15:39 says, "You will have these tassels to look at and so you will remember all the commands of the LORD, that you may obey them and not prostitute yourselves by chasing after the lusts of your own hearts and eyes" (NIV).

Both the Old and New Testaments describe God's people as being married to God (Jer. 31:33; 2 Cor. 11:2). Wives are expected to give themselves exclusively to their husbands. Gomer prostituted herself when she chased after lovers other than her husband, Hosea (cf. Hos. 3:3). When we take devotion or obedience that should be given to God and give them to another, we are prostitutes, unfaithful to our Husband.

According to Exodus 34:15, idolatry is prostitution. Do not think that the only way to commit idolatry is to bow down to a stone. Paul called covetousness idolatry (Eph. 5:5; Col. 3:5). An idol is anything that we love more, trust more and serve more than God. A job, hobby, family or money can be one's idol.

According to Numbers 15:39, self-will is idolatry. Whenever I chose to disobey God by following my own heart's desire, I am robbing God of service that is rightfully his.

God is a jealous husband (Exod. 34:14). Let's not arouse that jealousy by prostitution, by robbing God of the devotion and obedience that are rightfully his.
