

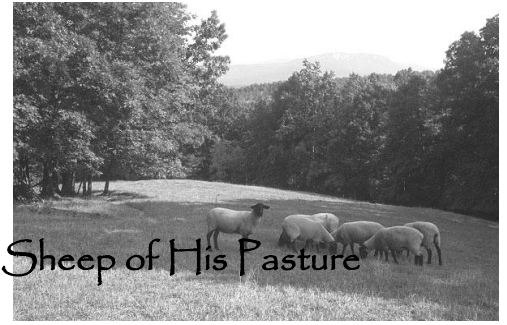

"God Said It. That Settles It"

Kim Davis, a county clerk in Moorehead, KY, has refused to issue marriage licenses to homosexual couples because of her religious beliefs. During a standoff with a homosexual couple, Davis said, "I simply told you, I'm willing to face my consequences, and you all will face your consequences when it comes time for judgment." One of the men replied, "We don't have consequences. I don't believe in judgment."

It is popular for Christians to say, "God said it. I believe it. That settles it." Actually, this is a VERY false statement. If God said it, then it is settled whether I believe it or not. "Your word, LORD, is eternal; it stands firm in the heavens" (Psa. 119:89 NIV).

In 1980 geologists warned of an imminent eruption of Mount St. Helens. They encouraged all to evacuate the mountain. Harry Truman (not the President), owned a lodge on Spirit Lake. He refused to believe their predictions and would not evacuate. Truman said, "I don't have any idea whether it will blow...But I don't believe to the point that I'm going to pack up...The mountain ain't gonna hurt me." You know the rest of the story. In spite of Truman's disbelief, he died in the eruption on May 18, 1980.

Truths don't have to be believed in order to make them reality. The coming day of judgment was taught by Jesus (Matt. 16:27); it is settled truth. "Speak and act as those who are going to be judged by the law that gives freedom" (Jam. 2:12 NIV).
