

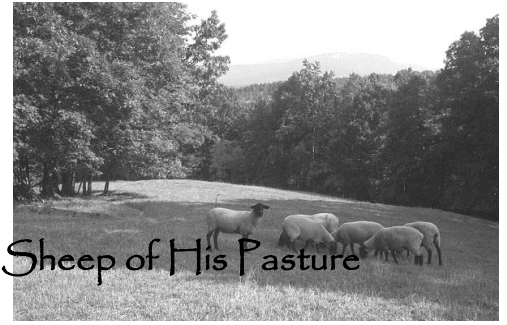

## "The King Eternal"

At 4 pm on September 9, 2015, Queen Elizabeth II became the longest serving British monarch since William the Conqueror became king in 1066. Queen Elizabeth ascended to the throne when her father, King George VI, died of cancer on February 6, 1952. The previously longest-reigning British monarch was Elizabeth's great-grandmother, Queen Victoria. Though Elizabeth's reign has been long (63 years and seven months), it will come to an end.

Jesus has been reigning for much longer than Elizabeth. He reigns over a kingdom which isn't earthly or material. Jesus told Pilate, "My kingdom is not of this world. If it were, my servants would fight to prevent my arrest by the Jewish leaders. But now my kingdom is from another place" (John 18:36 NIV). Jesus resisted the Jews who wanted to make him an earthly king (John 6:15). Rather Jesus' kingdom is a reign in the hearts and lives of his followers. Luke records, "Once, on being asked by the Pharisees when the kingdom of God would come, Jesus replied, 'The coming of the kingdom of God is not something that can be observed, nor will people say, 'Here it is,' or 'There it is,' because the kingdom of God is within you" (Luke 17:20-21 NIV).

Jesus ascended to his throne when he returned to heaven after his death and resurrection (Acts 2:29-36). The angel Gabriel gave this testimony concerning Jesus, "He will be great and will be called the Son of the Most High. The Lord God will give him the throne of his father David, and he will reign over Jacob's descendants forever; his kingdom will never end" (Luke 1:32-33 NIV). His is "the eternal kingdom of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ" (2 Pet. 1:11 NIV).

In America we have no obligation to the British crown; we declared our independence on July 4, 1776. However, all people everywhere have an obligation to bow their knees to Jesus and to allow his kingdom to rule their hearts. "Therefore God exalted him to the highest place and gave him the name that is above every name, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue acknowledge that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father" (Phil. 2:9-11 NIV).
