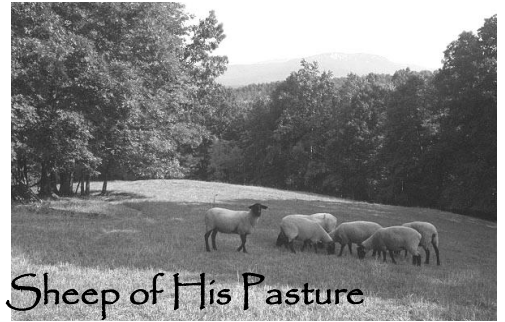

## "A Missing Body"

Julie Mott died of cystic fibrosis on August 8 at the young age of 25. Her funeral was conducted on August 15 at the Mission Parks Funeral Chapel North in San Antonio. Following the funeral service, her body was removed from the chapel and taken to a private family visitation room, where it was to remain until it was to be transported to a crematory on the following Monday. When funeral home workers went to get Mott's body on that Monday, it was gone. No one knows what happened to her body.

The assumption that the funeral home, the police and Mott's family have made is that someone stole Mott's body. The last person to leave the Mission Parks chapel after the funeral service was a man in his 20's who was described as having being obsessed with Mott. He was suspected for the crime.

When Jesus' body was missing from Joseph's tomb on the third day after his execution, the disciples first assumption was that someone stole the body (John 20:2, 13, 15). The unbelieving Jews made the claim for over 100 years that Jesus own disciples stole his body (Matt. 28:11-15). The disciples did not consider the possibility of resurrection until the angel revealed that Jesus had risen (Matt. 28:5-7).

While it is pretty safe to assume that Julie Mott's body was carried from the Mission Parks Funeral Chapel by someone rather than walking out on it's own, we can have confidence that Jesus left his tomb on his own power. His disciples did not steal his body. We can be assured of this because they suffered and died for their claim that Jesus' rose without having any good motive for lying. Their testimony of resurrection gained them nothing profitable of a worldly nature, but only what was painful.

The day is coming when all caskets, all urns, all tombs, yea "the sea...and death and Hades" will give up the dead that are in them. It will not be that any grave robber will violate those hallowed grounds. Rather it will be the case that "the Living One [who holds] the keys of death and Hades" (Rev. 1:18 NIV) will use these keys and will free "all who are in the graves" (John 5:28 NIV).
