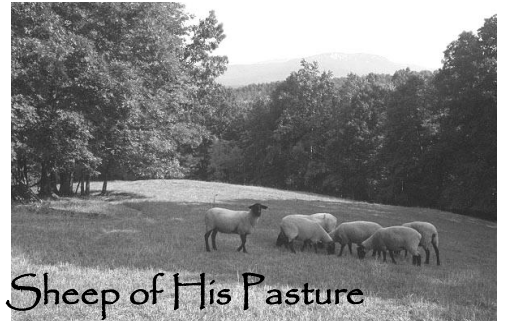

## Nazarenes

One of the earliest names given to Christians was Nazarene. When Paul was accused before Felix, the Jewish lawyer Tertullus called Paul "a ringleader of the Nazarene sect" (Acts 24:5 NIV). The English Standard Version records that Paul was "a ringleader of the sect of the Nazarenes." The word translated Nazarene in the NIV and Nazarenes in the ESV is plural. Thus each Christian was described as a Nazarene. The obvious import of that is that a Nazarene was a follower of "Jesus of Nazareth" (Acts 2:22; 3:6; 4:10; 6:14; et al.).

Nazareth was a town in Galilee (Luke 2:4). Though Jesus was born in Bethlehem (Matt. 2:1), his mother Mary and Joseph were from Nazareth (Luke 1:26; 2:4). After Joseph, Mary and Jesus left Egypt, they moved to Nazareth (Matt. 2:23), and that was where Jesus grew up (Luke 4:16). In fact Jesus lived there until he began his public ministry (Mark 1:9; Matt. 4:12-13).

Jesus' having lived in Nazareth was significant. Matthew said that it occurred so "that what was spoken by the prophets might be fulfilled: 'He shall be called a Nazarene'" (2:23 ESV). This passage has puzzled scholars because there is no one Old Testament passage that says, "He shall be called a Nazarene." Some scholars have noted that Matthew doesn't say that "what was spoken by the prophet (singular) might be fulfilled," but "what was spoken by the prophets (plural) might be fulfilled." In other words, Jesus' life in Nazareth fulfilled the overall message of the prophets concerning the type of Messiah that he would be.

When Philip was trying to get Nathanael to come to see Jesus, Philip called him "Jesus of Nazareth" (John 1:45 NIV). Nathanael famously replied, "Nazareth! Can anything good come from there?" (John 1:46). Jews from Judea looked down on "Galilee of the Gentiles" (John 7:52; cf. Matt. 4:15), and apparently everyone looked down on Nazareth. The message of the prophets was that Messiah would be despised by men (Isa. 53:3; Psa. 22:6; et al.). That was fulfilled in part by Jesus being a Nazarene.

The world means no compliment in calling Christians Nazarenes. It means that we are despised just as our Lord was. However, that should cause us no grief. Jesus said, "Woe to you when everyone speaks well of you" (Luke 6:26 NIV). Our concern should be to please God and not man (Gal. 1:10). May we all courageously "go to [Jesus] outside the camp, bearing the disgrace he bore" (Heb. 13:13 NIV).
