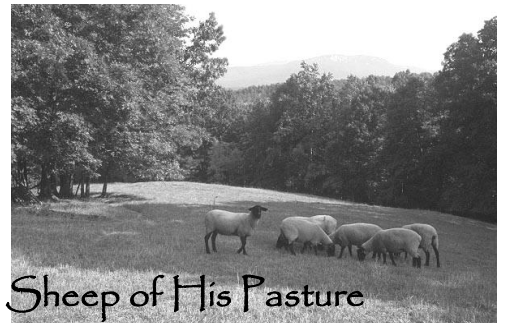

## " DEMONIC ACTIVITY "

Last Wednesday a house in Gary, Indiana, reported to have been the location of demonic activity was torn down. Latoya Ammons claimed that she and her three children had been possessed in that house in 2012. She claimed that the walls seeped a clear fluid, that there were sounds of footsteps in the basement, and that her children levitated and were hurled across the room. Ammons also reported that there were various visible manifestations of the demons in the form of a black monster and also as an aged woman with red eyes and a hood. Zak Baggans, the host and producer of the television show Ghost Adventures, bought the house in 2014 for \$35,000. He made the decision to have the house demolished.

Stories such as this one are not new. The 1970's novel and movie, *The Exorcist*, was based upon the story of a supposed 1949 demonic possession and exorcism in Cottage City, Maryland.

Tales of haunted houses, possessions and exorcisms certainly sell, as they appeal to people's strange desire to be frightened. However, what people should be more interested in and more frightened by is demonic temptation which is universal.

Paul speaks of "the ruler of the kingdom of the air, the spirit who is now at work in those who are disobedient" (Eph. 2:2 NIV). He closes that letter by saying, "For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms" (6:13 NIV).

The devil cunningly gets people stirred up about the extreme and, probably, mostly fictional cases of demonic levitation and spinning heads, and in so doing he blinds them to the more subtle, but far more deadly, influence that he would like to have over them. "Put on the whole armor of God, so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes" (Eph. 6:11 NIV).

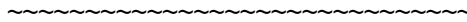
