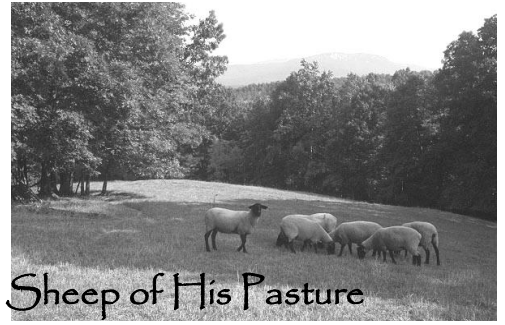

"Assault With An Alligator"

Joshua James of Jupiter, Florida, is accused of having thrown a three-and-one-half-foot alligator through the drive-through window at a local Wendy's restaurant. James is said to have placed his order, pulled up to the window and received his drink. It was at this point that he allegedly threw the gator at the Wendy's employee who was working the window.

Let's be honest. Who hasn't felt like throwing an alligator at a fast-food worker who messed up their order and treated them rudely? We probably haven't had access to an alligator to throw, but some of us have probably thrown vipers. David said this of his accusers, "They make their tongues as sharp as a serpent's; the poison of vipers is on their lips" (Psa. 140:3 NIV).

It is fair to say that too many people in service jobs don't have servants' hearts. Some probably deserve a rebuke (Luke 17:3-4); and when you are paying for a service you have the right to criticize the service offered (cf. 1 Cor. 4:2). However, we never know what may have happened in these people's lives that may have influenced their job performance and their treatment of us. Perhaps the cause of Christ would be better served if we responded with kindness. Solomon wrote, "A gentle ("Or healing" ESV footnote) tongue is a tree of life, but perverseness breaks the spirit" (Prov. 15:4 ESV).

The next time we go through a drive-through window, rather than throwing alligators or vipers, let's throw the fruit of life through kind words.
