

#### "Accidents and Curses"

An unbelievable thing happened last Sunday at a basketball tournament in Wisconsin. Two teams of eighth-grade girls were playing. A fourteen-year-old girl ran under the basket and fell. She told the referee that she could not get up. When people tried to help the girl up they discovered that she had been impaled on a giant splinter from the gym's wooden floorboards. That splinter was three or four inches long and had pierced her abdomen. Rescuers had to remove a part of the floorboard so that she could be transported to the hospital where the splinter was removed. All of her vital organs were missed and she was released from the hospital on Monday.

This girl's impalement on a splinter was a tragic accident. However, in Israel there were times when rebellious people were intentionally hung on trees. Moses instructed concerning these cases, "If someone guilty of a capital offense is put to death and their body is exposed on a pole ("tree" ESV), you must not leave the body hanging on the pole overnight. Be sure to bury it the same day, because anyone who is hung on a pole is under God's curse. You must not desecrate the land the LORD your God is giving you as an inheritance" (Deut. 21:22-23 NIV).

The King of Ai was hung on a pole according to this regulation in Joshua 8:28-29. But the most well-known example of this regulation was in the case of Jesus (John 19:31-37). Paul quoted the above passage from Deuteronomy in his letter to the Galatian churches. He wrote, "Christ redeemed us from the curse of the law by becoming a curse for us, for it is written: 'Cursed is everyone who is hung on a pole ("tree" ESV)'" (3:13).

Though the Wisconsin eighth grade girl was accidentally impaled, Jesus' crucifixion was no accident. His sinless life had merited for him God's blessing. Our sin had merited for us God's curse. Jesus took the pole that we all deserved, being subject to God's curse, so that he could redeem us from that curse. Jesus was cursed so that we might be blessed.
