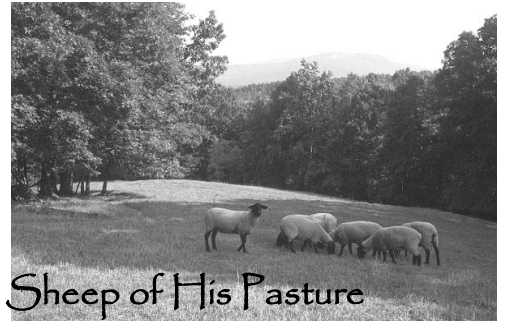

"Is Justice Scalia in Purgatory?"

Those who are of a more liberal political persuasion might wish worse upon Supreme Court Justice Antonin Scalia, who died on February 13, than Purgatory. However, Reverend Paul Scalia, Justice Scalia's son, hinted that his father is now in Purgatory in the eulogy that he gave in honor of his father at his funeral. Paul said, "He was a practicing Catholic, 'practicing' in the sense that he hadn't perfected it yet. Or rather, Christ was not yet perfected in him. And only those in whom Christ is brought to perfection can enter heaven. We are here, then, to lend our prayers to that perfecting to that final work of God's grace, in freeing Dad from every encumbrance of sin."

The Catechism of the Catholic Church says the following about Purgatory, "All who die in God's grace and friendship, but still imperfectly purified, are indeed assured of their eternal salvation; but after death they undergo purification, so as to achieve the holiness necessary to enter the joy of heaven. The Church gives the name Purgatory to this final purification of the elect, which is entirely different from the punishment of the damned...From the beginning the Church has honored the memory of the dead and offered prayers in suffrage for them, above all the Eucharistic sacrifice, so that, thus purified, they may attain the beatific vision of God" (para. 1030-1032).

"What does Scripture say?" (Rom. 4:3 NIV). One of the thieves who was crucified by Jesus' side cried out, "Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom" (Luke 23:42 NIV). It is certainly clear that this thief died in penitence, but it is also clear that this thief was no where close to perfection. Jesus promise to him is instructive. He said, "Truly I tell you, today you will be with me in paradise" (Luke 23:43 NIV). Jesus did not say, "Today you will be with me in Purgatory." Neither did he say, "One day you will be with me in Paradise after you've been purged." He said, "Today you will be with me in paradise." I don't think that anyone would confuse Purgatory with paradise.

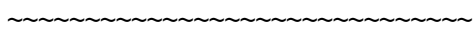
