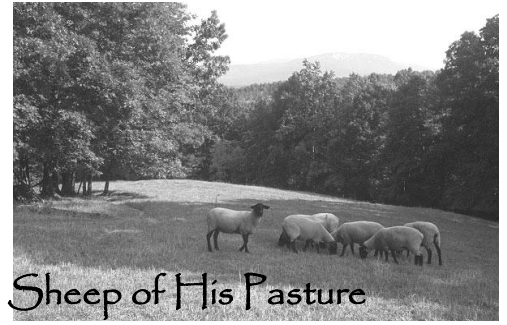

## "Who Are the Evangelical Christians?"

There is a lot of talk about Evangelical Christians during this election season. Some Presidential candidates have solicited votes from Evangelicals. Who exactly are the Evangelical Christians?

The term "Evangelical" is from the Greek word "euangelion," which is translated in English New Testaments as "gospel." The term received a lot of national attention with Jimmy Carter's run for the Presidency. Carter was identified as an Evangelical. A Time Magazine article named 1976 "the year of the evangelical."

The Evangelical movement is really a development of the Fundamentalism of the early 20th Century. Fundamentalists were those who stood for the fundamentals of the Christian faith (eg. creation, supernaturalism, the virgin birth of Christ, etc.) and were opposed to the modernism of liberals (i.e., anti-supernaturalism and evolution). At the mid-point of the 20th Century, conservatives who were uncomfortable with the belligerence and, often, anti-intellectualism of Fundamentalism, began to identify themselves as Evangelicals.

Evangelicals are not isolated to one particular denomination or branch of Christendom. Four characteristics are generally considered to be the essential defining qualities of Evangelicalism. According to historian David Bebbington they are:

-Biblicism: the belief that the Bible is the final authority in life and religion.

-Crucicentrism: the belief that salvation is only found through the work of Christ on the cross.

-Conversionism: the belief that only those who have been personally converted by the gospel are saved.

-Activism: the belief that Christians have a mandate from God to actively evangelize the lost.

Who are Evangelicals? People who hold to these four values.
