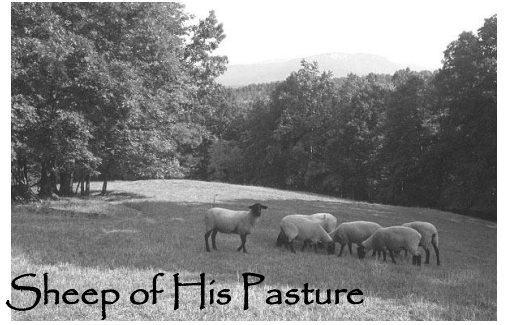

## "John's Writings"

The New Testament is an amazing collection of documents. It is composed of 27 books which were written by 8 or 9 different Christians (excluding secretaries who had a part in writing, cf. Rom. 16:22; 1 Pet. 5:12). Of these 8 or 9 different writers, 4 of them were apostles (Matthew, John, Paul and Peter) and 4 or 5 of them were New Testament prophets (Mark, Luke, James, Jude and possibly the writer of Hebrews, whoever he was).

The apostle John is responsible for having written the second largest number of books (5; cf. Paul's 13 or 14, if he wrote Hebrews) and the third greatest volume of material (Luke wrote the most having written Luke and Acts and Paul wrote the second most).

One of the great things about John's writings is that he often tells us his purpose for his having written.

John wrote in his gospel, "Jesus performed many other signs in the presence of his disciples, which are not recorded in this book. But these are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in his name" (John 20:30-31 NIV). John's gospel, unlike the Synoptics, is structured around 8 of Jesus' major miracles. In light of John's stated purpose, John is a wonderful gospel to give to an unbeliever to read if you are trying to convert him to Christ.

John wrote in his first letter, "I write these things to you who believe in the name of the Son of God so that you may know that you have eternal life" (1 John 5:13 NIV). This purpose statement is often misunderstood. Some think that it is a universal promise of life to all believers. Actually, in John's letter he gave tests that believers are to apply to themselves (eg. 1:6; 2:3-4; et al.). If we pass these tests, then John says that as a result of what he has written we can know that we have life.

John's final book, Revelation, begins with this beatitude, "Blessed is the one who reads aloud the words of this prophecy, and blessed are those who hear it and take to heart what is written in it, because the time is near" (1:3 NIV). The whole message of Revelation for Christians is that we have the ultimate victory over Satan and all of his forces through Jesus Christ (12:11; et al.).

Thus John's gospel was written for faith, his first letter was written for hope and his last book was written for joy!

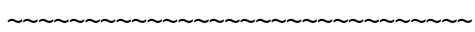
