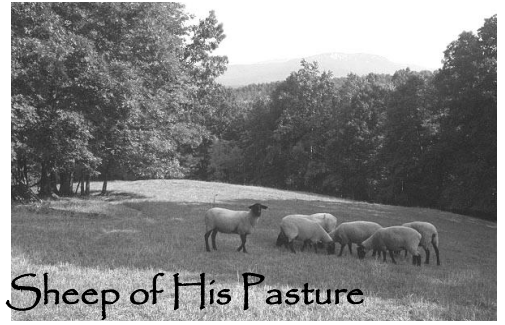

## "AN INDICATOR OF ONE'S CHARACTER"

Ruth is one of the most beautiful stories in the Bible. The main action of the book takes place during the barley harvest in Bethlehem (Ruth 1:22). This harvest took place around April.

In Palestine, work in the fields, such as harvesting barley, was done by day laborers (cf. Matt. 20:1-16). Moses warned those who hired workers for their fields to be fair with them. He wrote, "Do not take advantage of a hired worker who is poor and needy, whether that worker is a fellow Israelite or a foreigner residing in one of your towns. Pay them their wages each day before sunset, because they are poor and are counting on it. Otherwise they may cry to the LORD against you, and you will be guilty of sin" (Deut. 24:14-15 NIV).

Boaz was a wealthy landowner. He hired workers to harvest his barley crop. Ruth 2:4 says, "Just then Boaz arrived from Bethlehem and greeted the harvesters, 'The LORD be with you!' 'The LORD bless you!' they answered." Remember that Moses warned landowners to treat their day laborers fairly lest they cry out to God against them. Boaz's workers blessed him; they didn't curse him. That must mean that Boaz treated his workers fairly. Boaz was a great man, as Ruth attests!

One of the greatest indicators of one's character is what those who are under them say about them. What do your employees say about you behind your back? What do those you manage say about you around the coffee pot? How does the guy who mows your yard talk about you to his family? What do our children say about us when no one else is at home? The answers to these questions might reveal a lot about our characters.
