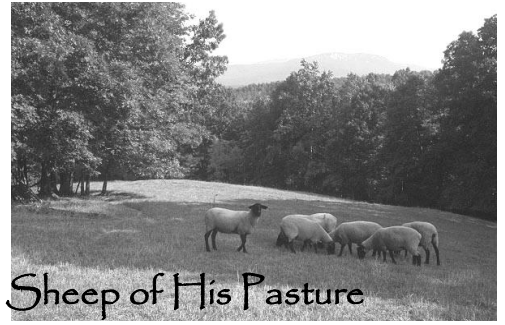

## "Donating Blood"

Carter Blood Care is scheduled to be at Meadow View on Sunday, May 15, to give people the opportunity to donate blood. According to the American Red Cross, every day in the United States there is a need for 36,000 units of red blood, 7,000 units of platelets and 10,000 units of plasma. Blood that has been donated has a 42-day shelf life.

A recent article in USA Today told about Bill Hall of Naples, Florida. Hall, 75, has donated blood 438 times. He said, "By giving blood, you give the gift of good health to someone who is hurting. There's no downside to that." Also, as of February 2015, a local man, Terry Price of Denton, Texas, had donated plasma 1,000 times, which is the most of anyone.

There is no verse in the Bible that speaks about donating blood per se. However, Jesus, who said, "It is more blessed to give than to receive" (Acts 20:35 NIV), donated his blood for everyone. He is the Great Physician who came to treat those of us who are spiritually sick (Matt. 9:12). He knew our need for blood (Heb. 9:22). He said prophesically, "This is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins" (Matt. 26:28 NIV). Jesus' blood wasn't collected in a bag when he donated it for us. It ran down his side (John 19:34). However, it wasn't lost. He collected that blood in his resurrection and carried it to heaven (Heb. 9:12). Now anyone who recognizes their sin sickness can access that blood by faith (Rom. 3:25 KJV).

Jesus donated his blood to give us spiritual life. We should be thankful that modern medicine has given us the opportunity to donate blood for people's physical life.
