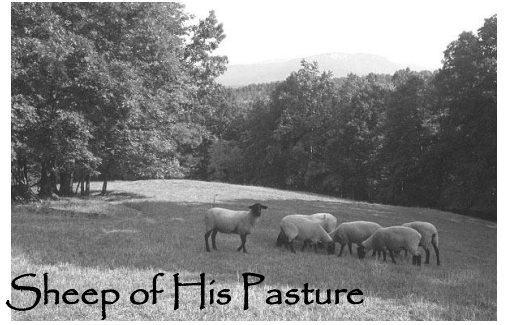

## "The Saint's Security"

Some groups teach that Christians have absolute security--that they can never be lost. The following is an expression of that position from a denomination's official statement of faith. "All true believers endure to the end. Those whom God has accepted in Christ, and sanctified by His Spirit, will never fall away from the state of grace, but shall persevere to the end. Believers may fall into sin through neglect and temptation, whereby they grieve the Spirit, impair their graces and comforts, and bring reproach on the cause of Christ and temporal judgments on themselves; yet they shall be kept by the power of God through faith unto salvation."

I do not think that the Bible teaches that believers have absolute security, that they can sin with hard hearts and pass unscathed through God's judgment into heaven (cf. Ezek. 18:24). On the other hand, I don't believe that the Bible teaches the insecurity of the believer, that they can never be sure of their eternal destiny (cf. 1 John 5:13). The Bible teaches a middle position; it teaches that Christians have a conditional security.

One of the clearest places where this mediating position of conditional security is taught is in 1 Peter 1:5, the passage referenced at the end of the quote from the statement of faith. Peter, who was very familiar with man's weakness and Jesus' faithfulness, wrote of Christians, "[W]ho through faith are shielded by God's power until the coming of the salvation that is ready to be revealed in the last time" (NIV). Peter promises that God, in his almighty power, shields Christians from all of Satan's attacks (cf. Eph. 6:10-18). He provides this protection so long as Christians maintain their faith (cf. Eph. 6:16), which includes the idea of a faithful/obedient lifestyle (cf. Heb. 11:8).

Faithfulness is often misunderstood as perfection. Scripture clearly teaches that moral perfection is impossible this side of heaven (1 John 1:8, 10). It gives examples of Christians who, like Paul, were not perfect (Phil. 3:12) and yet were confident of their heavenly reward (2 Tim. 4:8). As we walk that faithful walk we, in our weakness, sin in ways that we aren't even aware of (Psa. 19:12). But we are promised in 1 John 1:7 that Jesus' blood cleanses us from those sins that we don't even know to confess provided that we keep on walking in the right direction.
