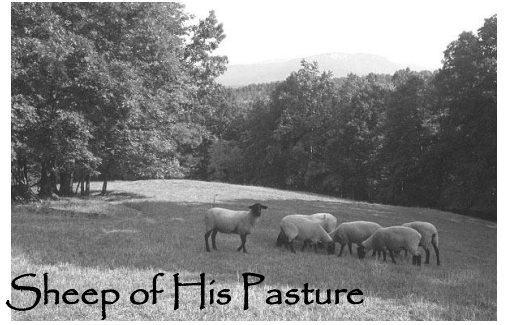

MOTHERS IN SCRIPTURE

Today is a day that we set aside to honor the mothers in our lives in a special way. When we think of our mothers, we probably think about our biological mothers. However, the Bible indicates that we have more mothers than just the ones who gave birth to us.

Job spoke of Mother Earth. After having lost his wealth and children, the suffering patriarch lamented, "Naked I came from my mother's womb, and naked I will return there" (Job 1:21 footnote, NIV). A good commentary on Job's statement is Genesis 3:19, which says, "By the sweat of your brow you will eat your food until you return to the ground, since from it you were taken; for dust you are and to dust you will return" (NIV). The origin of the first person was the earth (Gen. 2:7) and the intermediate destiny of all people is the earth in their burial.

Paul spoke of Mother Heaven. He wrote an allegory drawn from the lives of Abraham, Sarah, Hagar, Ishmael and Isaac to prove that Christianity has superseded Judaism. In that context, Paul wrote, "But the Jerusalem that is above is free, and she is our mother" (Gal. 4:26 NIV). Hebrews 12:22-23 speaks of "the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem" where "the church of the firstborn, whose names are written in heaven" are considered to be citizens (Phil. 3:20). Heaven is our mother-city.

Jesus spoke of Mother Christians. Sometimes becoming a Christian requires the loss of a relationship with unbelieving family members. Jesus made a promise to Christians who make those sorts of sacrifices. He said, "Truly I tell you, no one who has left home or brothers or sisters or mother or father or children or fields for me and the gospel will fail to receive a hundred times as much in this present age: homes, brothers, sisters, mothers, children and fields--along with persecutions--and in the age to come eternal life." (Mark 10:29-30 NIV). Paul testified to the faithfulness of this promise when he wrote, "Greet Rufus, chosen in the Lord, and his mother, who has been a mother to me, too" (Rom. 16:13 NIV).
