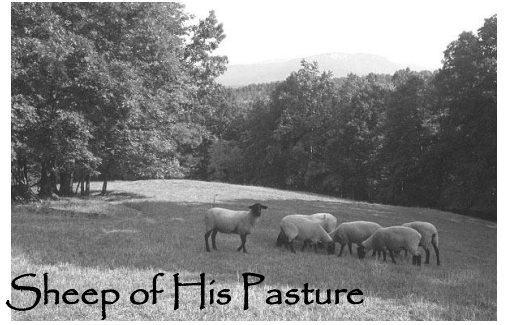

## **EXCELLENCE**

Daniel was an incredible man. The book bearing his name contains a remarkable compliment given to him by God. The angel Gabriel told Daniel that the reason the vision of the Seventy Weeks was given to him was because he was "highly esteemed" in heaven (9:23 NIV). Ezekiel, who was a slightly older contemporary of Daniel and a fellow captive in Babylon, placed him in company with such stalwarts as Noah and Job (Ezek. 14:14, 20).

Daniel wasn't just held in high esteem by God and the people of God. The pagans also thought highly of him. Throughout the Neo-Babylonian Empire, like cream, Daniel just kept rising to the top (Dan. 1:18-21; 2:48; 4:9; 5:29; 8:27). He also grew very prominent in the Medo-Persian Empire. "It pleased Darius to appoint 120 satraps to rule throughout the kingdom, with three administrators over them, one of whom was Daniel. The satraps were made accountable to them so that the king might not suffer loss. Now Daniel so distinguished himself among the administrators and the satraps by his exceptional qualities that the king planned to set him over the whole kingdom. At this, the administrators and the satraps tried to find grounds for charges against Daniel in his conduct of government affairs, but they were unable to do so. They could find no corruption in him, because he was trustworthy and neither corrupt nor negligent" (Dan. 6:1-4 NIV).

Daniel could not have achieved the prominence that he did apart from God's blessing (Dan. 1:9; Prov. 16:7). However, there can be no doubt that God blessed him because Daniel always strove for excellence with integrity. Proverbs 22:29 says, "Do you see someone skilled in their work? They will serve before kings; they will not serve before officials of low rank."

May we all strive for excellence with integrity in whatever we do as Daniel did. "Whatever your hand finds to do, do it with all your might" (Eccl. 9:10 NIV).
