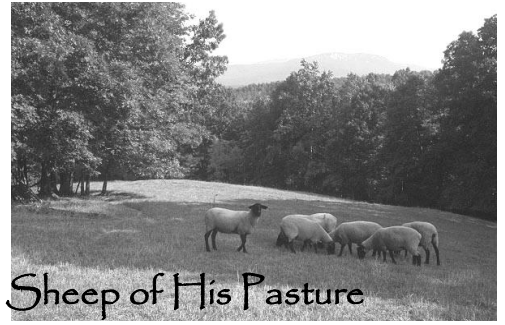

"A SORDID AFFAIR"

Monica Mares, 36, gave her son, Caleb Peterson, 19, up for adoption right after she gave birth to him. He was adopted by another family. Last year this mother and son were reunited. Their relationship quickly morphed into a romantic relationship, and the two began to live together.

The police in Clovis, New Mexico, responded to a domestic dispute next door to Mares and Peterson's house, and, in the process of their investigation, they learned of this incestuous relationship. Peterson admitted to having a sexual relationship with his mother.

Charges have been filed against this mother and son, and the trial has been scheduled for October 26. If they are convicted, they could each face up to 3 years in prison and a \$3,000 fine. Mares has two other children, ages 5 and 6. One wonders what will happen to them?

Cristina Shy is an advocate for Mares and Peterson. On her website is seeking to raise money to cover their legal fees. She writes, "It is a sad thing for the court system to prosecute consenting adults for loving each other and being together, and even worse when they tear happy families apart in the process. America needs to keep evolving. It was the same with gay people just a few years ago and now they can get married and they are accepted. Well, why not consanguinamorous people like us? We are all adults."

When one tampers with God's arrangement and redefines the proper bounds for marriage, where do they draw the line? Truly, it is a slippery slope. First, homosexuality, and now incest. Look out, because people will be pushing bestiality and even pedophilia in a short time.
