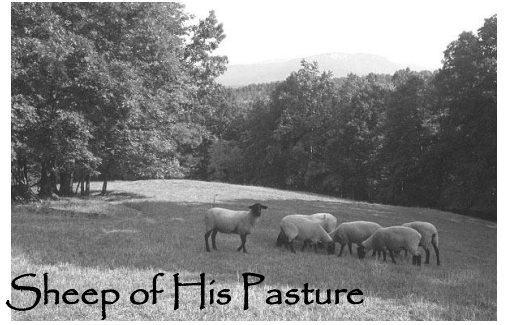

GOD'S INSPIRED AND PRESERVED WORD

Paul claimed that the books which we have in the Holy Bible are "God-breathed" (2 Tim. 3:16 NIV). Peter quoted Isaiah and contrasted man's transitoriness with Scriptures eternity, and said, "All people are like grass, and all their glory is like the flowers of the field; the grass withers and the flowers fall, but the word of the Lord endures forever" (1Pet.1:24-25NIV).

The pertinent question is: Where are God's inspired words preserved for us today?

Some claim that these words have been preserved for us in the King James Version of the Bible. Consider this quote from a church's "What We Believe" page: "We believe God not only inspired every word, but has preserved His inspired Word for us today in the King James Bible."

A major problem with this claim is the KJV itself. While it is a translation that God has mightily used for the past 400 years, and is still quite good, it contradicts itself. 2 Chronicles 22:2 in the KJV says, "Forty and two years old was Ahaziah when he began to reign." The previous chapter says of Jehoram, Ahaziah's father, "Thirty and two years old was he when he began to reign, and he reigned in Jerusalem eight years, and departed without being desired" (2 Chron. 21:20 KJV). If Jehoram was 40 when he died, how could Ahaziah, his son, have been 42 when he became king? That means that the son was 2 years older than his father! Translations like the NIV do a good job here by following the Greek version of 2 Chronicles 22:2 (which agrees with the parallel passage in 2 Kings 8:26) and says that Ahaziah was 22 when his father died and he became king.

God's words aren't preserved in any one translation. Neither are God's words preserved in any one Hebrew manuscript of the Old Testament or Greek Manuscript of the New Testament. Rather, within the great mass of Hebrew manuscripts and other ancient versions of the Old Testament and Greek manuscripts of the New Testament God has preserved his infallible word. Modern translation like the NIV and ESV do a good job sorting through the various readings and choosing those that seem to be the original ones.
