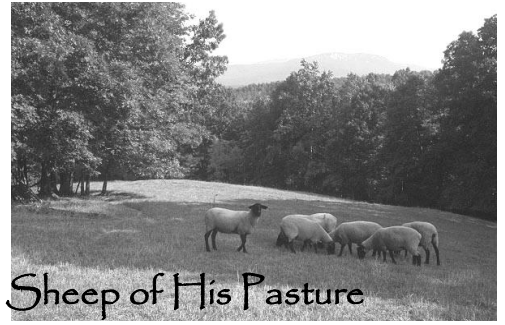

PURE WORSHIP

Malachi prophesied to the Jewish nation after it had been repatriated and after the temple had been rebuilt. God wasn't pleased with what his people were doing at the temple. He said, "Oh, that one of you would shut the temple doors, so that you would not light useless fires on my altar! I am not pleased with you," says the LORD Almighty, "and I will accept no offering from your hands" (Mal. 1:10 NIV).

Why was God so disgusted with the Jews' worship at the temple? The prophet wrote, "It is you priests who show contempt for my name...By offering defiled food on my altar" (vv. 6-7 NIV). These people didn't reverence God. Thus they offered him disrespectful sacrifices, contrary to what he had commanded in his Word.

Malachi went on to foretell, "My name will be great among the nations, from where the sun rises to where it sets. In every place incense and pure offerings will be brought to me, because my name will be great among the nations," says the LORD Almighty" (v. 11 NIV).

The writer of the early Christian document known as The Teaching of the Twelve Apostles interpreted Malachi 1:11 as being fulfilled in the church's worship. He wrote the following about the same time that John wrote Revelation: "On the Lord's own day (Sunday, MH) when you gather together, break bread and give thanks (eat the Lord's Supper, MH) after you have confessed your unlawful deeds, that your sacrifice may be pure. Let no one quarreling with his neighbor join you until they are reconciled, that your sacrifice may not be defiled. For this is the sacrifice mentioned by the Lord: 'In every place and time, bring me a pure sacrifice. For I am a great King, says the Lord, and my name is considered marvelous among the Gentiles'" (chapter 14).

May we all strive to offer the Lord pure sacrifices from reverent hearts this morning.
