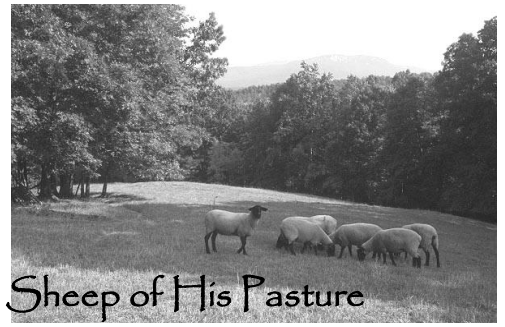

## WASHINGTON IS BROKEN

Justice Clarence Thomas spoke at the Heritage Foundation on the occasion of the 25th anniversary of his having been sworn into the Supreme Court. Thomas said of Washington, "This city is broken in some ways...At some point, we are going to have to recognize that we are destroying our institutions."

I don't think that many people would disagree with this justice's opinion. It is, probably, the majority opinion.

We can easily become discouraged when we reflect on the state of our nation and the direction of our nation. Discouragement can lead to hopelessness. However, as Christians, we have no cause for hopelessness.

Christians are dual citizens. Though we all value our American citizenship, we have a citizenship that is infinitely more valuable than it. Paul wrote, "But our citizenship is in heaven" (Phil. 3:20 NIV). David wrote, "The LORD has established his throne in heaven, and his kingdom rules over all" (Psa. 103:19 NIV).

Israel in David's day was similar to America today. With Saul on the throne the nation was experiencing turmoil. In light of that, David asked, "When the foundations are being destroyed, what can the righteous do?" (Psa. 11:3 NIV). He quickly gave answer, "The LORD is in his holy temple; the LORD is on his throne" (v. 4 NIV).

May we find comfort in this truth just as David did. The capital city pertaining to our earthly citizenship may be broken, but the capital city pertaining to our heavenly citizenship stands secure.
