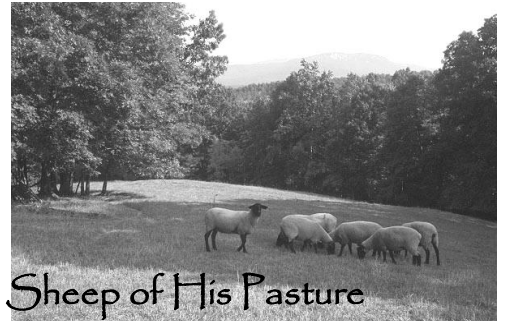

Reading the Bible

I saw a Facebook post which made the following surprising
claims.

-33% of high school graduates never read another book after
graduation.

-42% of college graduates never read another book after
graduation.

-57% of new books aren't read completely.

-80% of US families did not buy or read a book last year.

I don't know how those statistics were gathered, and I don't
know how accurate they are. However, I think that everyone
recognizes that our society is less literate than it used to be.

There is nothing morally wrong with not being a reader in
general. However, there is something very wrong with not
being a reader of God's word. Jesus rebuked the Sadducees,
"You are in error because you do not know the
Scriptures...Have you not read what God said to you?" (Matt.
22:29, 31 NIV). God created us to have fellowship with him
(James 4:8), and the way that we hear his voice is through his
word (Mark 7:13).

If one will discipline themselves to reading 3 chapters per day
and 5 chapters on Sundays, they can read through the whole
Bible in one year. Even if a person is a slow reader, they can
read these chapters in about 15 minutes.

The most fundamental help to reading the Bible profitably is
having a translation that is both accurate and readable. I
would recommend either the New International Version (NIV)
or the English Standard Version (ESV). The NIV is slightly
more readable and the ESV is slightly more literal, but both
accurately represent God's word in 21st century English.

Will you commit yourself to reading the Bible from Genesis to
Revelation in 2017?
