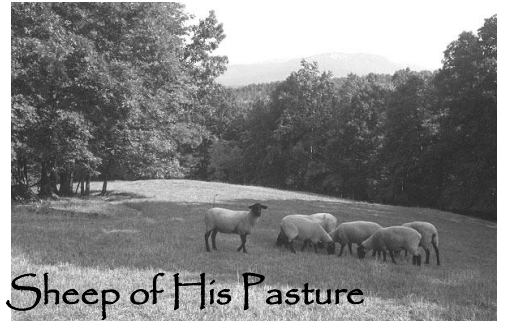

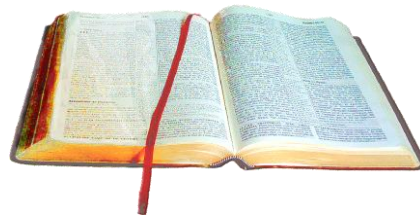

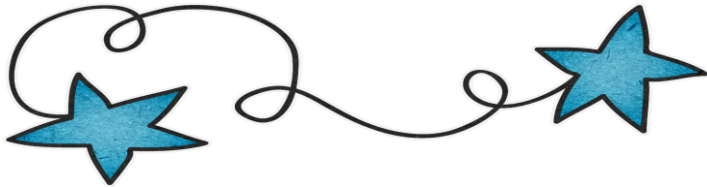

The Abundant Life

Fewer Americans are choosing to live their lives according to the Bible's teachings. Many people have voiced their opinion that the Bible's ethic is repressive.

Billy Joel eloquently stated this view in his song 'Only the Good Die Young.' The lyrics amount to an attempt to persuade Virginia, a Catholic girl, to engage in premarital sex. Joel sings, "They say there's a heaven for those who will wait. Some say it's better but I say it ain't. I'd rather laugh with the sinners than cry with the saints. The sinners are much more fun. You know that only the good die young."

Contrary to the above lyrics (which really are a rephrasing of the devil's lie to Eve in Genesis 3:1-6), Scripture's moral commands are designed by God to help people live the fullest life possible. Moses wrote, "And now, Israel, what does the LORD your God ask of you but to fear the LORD your God...and to observe the LORD's commands and decrees that I am giving you today for your own good?" (Deut. 10:12, 13 NIV).

The Bible is honest in agreeing with the world that sin is fun; it speaks of the "pleasures of sin" (Heb. 11:25 NIV). However, it is also honest about the wreckage that sin causes in people's lives; it speaks of "the fleeting pleasures of sin" (ibid.).

Proverbs 5 was written by Solomon to discourage the very thing that Billy Joel's song encourages. It focuses not upon the pleasures of the act but upon the problems that come in the aftermath. Solomon warns the promiscuous, "At the end of your life you will groan, when your flesh and body are spent" (v. 11 NIV). Magic Johnson can testify to the problems that come when one ignores biblical teachings and follows the ways of the world.

Jesus said, "I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly" (John 10:10 KJV). The Bible's good teachings are the way to the best life now!
