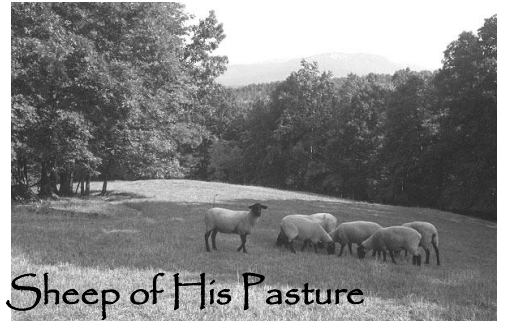

God Will Work it Out

Proverbs is an incredible book. Solomon, who was well-known for his wise proverbs (1 Ki. 4:32), wrote the sayings found in this book (Prov. 1:1; 10:1; 25:1), with the exception of the material found in chapters 30 and 31. However, Solomon was not the one who put the book together. Proverbs 25:1 says, "These are more proverbs of Solomon, compiled by the men of Hezekiah king of Judah." It isn't entirely clear who was responsible for the final form of the book; but what is clear is that the book was very purposefully arranged.

Proverbs naturally divides into a prologue and 7 sections of proverbs (1:8-9:18; 10:1-22:16; 22:17-24:22; 24:23-34; 25:1-29:27; ch. 30; ch. 31). Seven is the biblical number of completeness (cf. Prov. 6:16-19).

The second section (10:1-22:16) has 375 individual proverbs in it. These are explicitly called "the proverbs of Solomon" (10:1). Why are only 375 of Solomon's 3,000 proverbs (1 Ki. 4:32) included in this section? One possible answer is this: the numeric value of Solomon's name in Hebrew is 375. Gematria (i.e., determining the numeric value of a word based upon the values of its individual letters) is used in other passages of Scripture (Rev. 13:18).

Since then it appears that 375 proverbs were purposefully chosen, one cannot assume that they were just randomly arranged. The central proverb in this collection, that is, number 188, is Proverbs 16:4, "The LORD works out everything to its proper end--even the wicked for a day of disaster" (NIV).

This proverb can be translated a couple of different ways. The ESV reads, "The LORD has made everything for its purpose, even the wicked for the day of trouble." Translating with the word "made" implies a very Calvinistic idea, that God purposefully creates evil for his glory. This idea is contradicted by the very next proverb; "The LORD detests all the proud of heart" (NIV). The NIV translation of "works out" seems to be best.

The editor of Proverbs wanted us all to know that though things may appear to chaotic and off-track, God will finally bring a fitting resolution to everything, including destruction for sinners; God will work it out!
