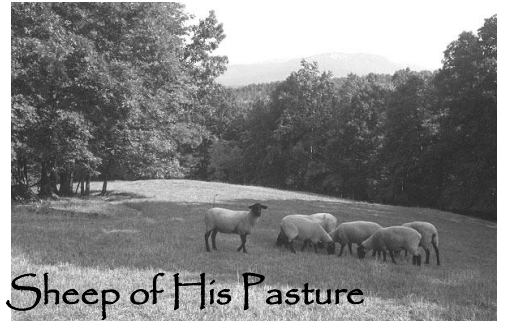

THE MINIMUM WAGE

There has been a lot of discussion about the minimum wage in our nation. Many have been pushing for a \$15 minimum wage, but currently the federal minimum wage is set at \$7.25 per hour.

An article in USA Today this past week said that the minimum wage reached its peak buying power in 1968. If you adjust the 1968 minimum wage for inflation it equals \$8.68 in 2017 dollars.

While I don't want to wade into politics by expressing any opinion about the minimum wage, it is important that we know that the Bible does teach that there are minimum wages as it relates to morality.

Nearly everyone is familiar with the minimum wage for sin. Paul wrote, "For the wages of sin is death" (Rom. 6:23 NIV). Jesus didn't teach that all sins were equally evil. He said that sins committed knowingly will be punished with "many blows," but sins committed in ignorance will be punished with "few blows" (Luke 12:47-48 NIV). Even though some will be "punished most severely" for their sins (Mark 12:40 NIV), the minimum wage for sin is death.

There is also a minimum wage for morality. Solomon wrote, "Humility is the fear of the LORD; its wages are riches and honor and life" (Prov. 22:4 NIV). The New Testament shows us that we shouldn't interpret "riches and honor and life" in a material way. Righteousness doesn't always bring earthly wealth (Matt. 8:20), but it always causes one to be "rich in faith" (Jam. 2:5 NIV). Sometimes the righteous are dishonored by the world (John 8:49), but they are always honored by God (Rom. 2:10). God's people have sometimes been put to death for righteousness (Matt. 5:10), but obeying God's "command leads to eternal life" (John 12:50 NIV). We may not receive any worldly benefit from serving God, but we always get spiritual riches, honor and life from him.
