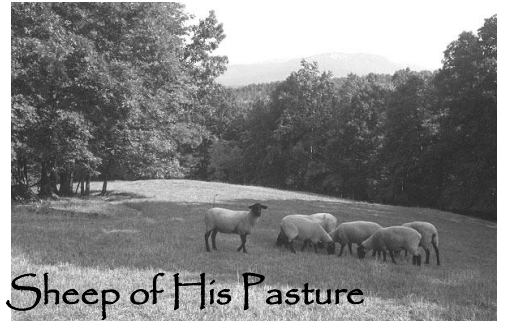

HAND WASHING

We've had a lot of sickness around our house, and so we have really doubled down on hand washing. Germ theory has demonstrated the great importance of this practice. The Bible also says a lot about hand washing.

The Bible writers had no knowledge of germ theory, but they did teach hand washing for ritual purification. The bronze basin was located in the court of the tabernacle between the altar and the curtain. God commanded, "Whenever [priests] enter the tent of meeting,...they shall wash their hands and feet [in the bronze basin] so that they will not die" (Exod. 30:20-21 NIV).

Further, with regard to ceremonial uncleanness, "Anyone the man with a discharge touches without rinsing his hands with water must wash their clothes and bathe with water, and they will be unclean till evening" (Lev. 15:11 NIV).

Hand washing was symbolic of a person's being innocent of murder. If a dead body were found in a field, and there were no witness of the murder, "then all the elders of the town nearest the body shall wash their hands...and they shall declare: 'Our hands did not shed this blood, nor did our eyes see it done'" (Deut. 19:6-7 NIV). This law is probably why David declared when he was being accused (of murder?, cf. v. 9), "I wash my hands in innocence" (Psa. 26:6 NIV). At Jesus' trial, Pilate also "took water and washed his hands in front of the crowd. 'I am innocent of this man's blood,' he said" (Matt. 27:24 NIV).

The Pharisees asked Jesus, "Why do your disciples break the tradition of the elders? They don't wash their hands before they eat!" (Matt. 15:2 NIV). This traditional hand washing had nothing to do with hygiene, but only ceremony. This is clear because, according to The Mishnah, tradition only required the volume of water for hand washing to amount to the bulk of an egg shell and a half.

David asked who would be allowed by God to approach him in worship. He gave the answer, "The one who has clean hands and a pure heart" (Psa. 24:4 NIV). "A pure heart" means that one must have holy intentions, and "clean hands" means that one must live a righteous life (cf. Prov. 15:8; 21:27).

Therefore, it is necessary for us all to wash our hands in repentance before we approach God in worship. James wrote, "Wash your hands, you sinners, and purify your hearts, you double-minded" (4:8 NIV).
