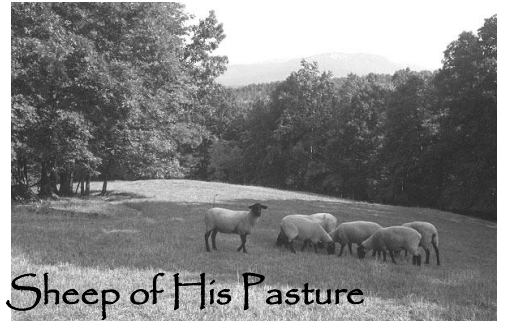

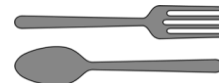
Congregational Potluck Luncheon

"God Is So Good"

If you had to describe God in one word, what would it be? Truly this is an impossible challenge. God is infinite; he can't be defined by a finite word. However, having said that, one probably can't do better than to go with the word "good." "The LORD is good" (Nah. 1:7 NIV).

Moses asked God, "Now show me your glory" (Exod. 33:18 NIV). God responded, "I will cause all my goodness to pass in front of you" (v. 19 NIV). It was God's goodness that Moses saw from the cleft of the rock.

We may call people good (Luke 23:50), but none actually are in the absolute sense (Psa. 14:2). God alone is good, as Jesus said, "No one is good--except God alone" (Mark 10:18 NIV).

We aren't allowed to see glorious manifestations of God's goodness this side of heaven as Moses was allowed to, but we still see God's goodness. As David said, "I remain confident of this: I will see the goodness of the LORD in the land of the living" (Psa. 27:13 NIV). David challenged us to experience God's goodness; "Taste and see that the LORD is good" (34:8 NIV).

How can we see and experience God's goodness? Take a moment to mentally list all of the good things that you have experienced in this life. Here are a few: existence; breathing; sunshine; food; love; kindness; family; beautiful sights; salvation; hope; et al. Enjoying these blessings is tantamount to tasting that God is good. All of these things have come from God, for James said, "Every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of the heavenly lights, who does not change like shifting shadows" (1:17 NIV). "I say to the LORD, 'You are my Lord; apart from you I have no good thing'" (Psa. 16:2 NIV).

Psalm 116:12 is an appropriate question for us; "What shall I return to the LORD for all his goodness to me?" (NIV). We should thank him for it; "Give thanks to the LORD, for he is good" (Psa. 118:1 NIV). Further, we should "follow God's example" and bear "fruit...in all goodness" (Eph. 5:1, 9 NIV).
