



THE STRENGTH OF FORGIVENESS

There has been an age-old debate over the nature of forgiveness: is it an act of strength or weakness? Some worldly-minded people say that forgiveness is weakness; strong people seek to get even. What does the Bible sav?

Numbers 13-14 are very sad chapters. Though God had miraculously delivered Israel from Egypt and supernaturally cared for them for going on two years. they rebelled against him and refused to go up to conquer Canaan. God had it, and he told Moses, "I will strike them down with a plague and destroy them, but I will make you into a nation greater and stronger than they" (14:12 NIV). Moses responded to God with this plea: "Now may the Lord's strength be displayed, just as you have declared: 'The LORD is slow to anger, abounding in love and forgiving sin and rebellion. Yet he does not leave the guilty unpunished; he punishes the children for the sin of the parents to the third and fourth generation.' In accordance with your great love, forgive the sin of these people, just as you have pardoned them from the time they left Egypt until now" (vv. 17-19 NIV). Note that God's strength, in part, is that he is "slow to anger, abounding in love and forgiving sin and rebellion."

There is no such thing as sin without loss. When sin is committed, either the sinner suffers the loss by being punished, or the person who forgives suffers the loss by not seeking restitution. When God forgives us, he does so on the basis of the fact that he suffered the loss by giving his Son to die the death penalty for the sin (cf. Matt. 26:28). Therefore, God forgives from a position of strength and not weakness. When we choose to forgive, we are actually choosing the harder path; we're choosing to bear the loss in the sin. Forgiveness is not an act of weakness, but of strength.
