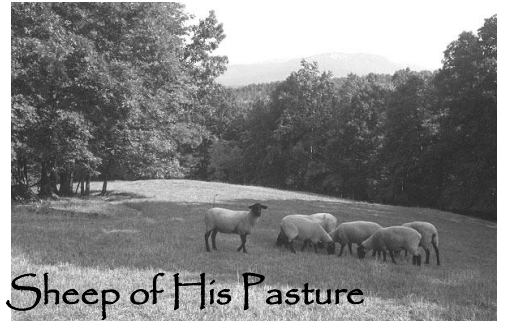

## ROADS

President Trump announced on Tuesday night that he will ask Congress to approve a \$1-trillion-dollar infrastructure bill. He said, "Another Republican President, Dwight D. Eisenhower, initiated the last truly great national infrastructure program--the building of the interstate highway system. The time has come for a new program of national rebuilding."

We're all thankful for the highway system that we have in our country, and the ease of travel that it affords us. Scripture describes roads that helped ancients travel. Exodus 13:17 says, "When Pharaoh let the people go, God did not lead them on the road through the Philistine country, though that was the shorter" (NIV). This road was called "Way of Horus" by the Egyptians. It was a military highway that went along the Mediterranean seacoast from the Egyptian fortress of Zilu to Raphia.

Moses said to the king of Edom, "Please let us pass through your country...We will travel along the King's Highway and not turn to the right or to the left until we have passed through your territory" (Num. 20:17 NIV). The King's Highway was the major north-south road between Damascus and Ezion-geber on the Red Sea's Gulf of Aqaba.

Isaiah foretold Jesus' being a light to "Galilee of the nations, by the Way of the Sea" (9:1 NIV). This road went from Dor on the Mediterranean Sea eastward around the southern end of the Sea of Galilee and then north to Hazor and Damascus.

The most important roads, however, that Scripture speaks of aren't physical roads, but spiritual ones. Jesus said, "Enter through the narrow gate. For wide is the gate and broad is the road that leads to destruction, and many enter through it. But small is the gate and narrow the road that leads to life, and only a few find it" (Matt. 7:13-14 NIV). According to Jesus, there are only two roads that we can take in life; one leads to heaven and the other to hell. Most people are on the one to hell, but they don't realize that it is the wrong road. Solomon said, "There is a way that appears to be right, but in the end it leads to death" (Prov. 14:12 NIV). The road that leads to heaven is one that you can only walk on if you follow Jesus. He said of himself, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me" (John 14:6 NIV).
