

Why I Need to Go to Church

The third book of Psalms opens on a dark note. Asaph, a Levite from the clan of Gershom (1 Chron, 6:39, 43), who was appointed along with Heman and Ethan by David to be "in charge of music in the house of the LORD" (1 Chron. 6:31 NIV), had become disenchanted with life. After having seen "the prosperity of the wicked" (Psa. 73:3 NIV), he concluded, "Surely in vain I have kept my heart pure and have washed my hands in innocence" (v. 13 NIV). In other words, Asaph felt like living a godly life is a waste of time since God allows the righteous to suffer and the wicked to prosper; and so why bother?

There was a period of time that Asaph wrestled with this problem on his own but he found no satisfying answers. His spiritual frustration became so great that he almost turned his back on his faith (v. 2)!

Asaph did finally find resolution to his struggle over injustice. Do you know where he found it? Church. He said, "When I tried to understand all this, it troubled me deeply till I entered the sanctuary of God; then I understood their final destiny" (Psa. 73:16-17 NIV). Only when Asaph went into God's house, presumably to serve in the song service, did he recognize that he has to look at the big picture, which includes the judgment and eternity, in order to see God's justice in punishing sin and rewarding righteousness.

Christians often struggle with life's inequities just as Asaph did. And they sometimes respond to their disillusionment by pulling away from church and Christians. They wrestle with their frustration in isolation from God and God's people. But we humans aren't equipped in our own mental faculties to arrive at solutions to life's big problems. Asaph admitted that his own thinking about the problem was stupid; he said, "When my heart was grieved and my spirit embittered, I was senseless and ignorant; I was a brute beast before you" (v. 21 NIV). When you and I are struggling with life, let us not pull away from church. Those are the very times that we need the church and Christians the most. In those times let us be more faithful in our attendance, and we'll find the answers we need in the sanctuary of God just as Asaph did.
