

THE MEADOW VIEW CONGREGATION IS ADDING A NEW MISSION POINT

The mission committee here at Meadow View asked the elders recently to consider supporting Bro. Serafin Rodriguez in Mexico. Serafin is in his 50s, married with 3 sons, and had attended the preacher school in Monterrey when he was a younger man. He worked full-time in the Lord's church after completing the preacher school with an American brother in W. Texas providing much of his support back then. At some point Serafin lost that support and took on secular work and in the intervening years he has continued to preach and teach and be involved with the congregation locally in Frontera, Coahuila, Mexico. More recently he has wanted to invest more time in a new church plant in another area of Monclovo, a larger town which is near Frontera. By the way, one other connection that we have to Serafin: Adriana Davis, Ann Healy's daughter-in-law, is his niece.

Last December Serafin came through Dallas and made a presentation to the mission committee here. We were favorably impressed with his demeanor, desire and commitment to the Lord. Others who know of him have communicated similar thoughts about him and his work in Mexico. In the meantime, Meadow View has decided to take on his support. He is ending his secular work this month and will be immediately investing more time and energy in the Lord's work in both Frontera and Monclovo.

As most of you are now aware, the mission works in Indonesia where we were involved with Cesar Besantes and Jerry Manawan were phased out after well over a decade and a half of mission involvement in that part of the world. This month, April 2017, was the last month for Meadow View and others to send support to them.

The Heart

'Heart' is a word that we commonly use in everyday speech, and it is also one of the most common words in the English Bible. These facts can lead to problems in understanding the Bible because 'heart' is used in some biblical contexts differently than it is commonly used.

In everyday speech, 'heart' is probably used most often to refer to the organ in the center of the chest that pumps blood to the rest of the body. The Bible also uses heart in this way, but not very often (1 Sam. 25:37; 2 Sam. 18:14; 2 Ki. 9:24).

Probably the second most common use of 'heart' in our speech is with reference to human emotions. The Bible also speaks of hate (Lev. 19:17), love (Deut. 13:3), fear (Isa. 35:4), sadness (Neh. 2:2), joy (Prov. 27:11), etc., as coming from the heart.

The point where the biblical usage and the popular usage really part ways is where the Bible uses 'heart' to refer to the intellectual, rational and volitional activities of man. This difference of usage explains why the NIV, which seeks the middle ground between transparency to the original text and accuracy in communicating to English speakers according to 21st-century usage, often translates the original Hebrew or Greek words corresponding to 'heart' in another way. However, the English Standard Version (ESV) routinely shows this intellectual usage of 'heart.' It speaks of people "questioning" (Mark 2:6) and "pondering" (Luke 2:19) with their hearts.

It is with the heart that we believe (Rom. 10:9) and obey (Rom. 6:17) the gospel. Paul also speaks of Christians "doing the will of God from [the] heart" (Eph. 6:6 NIV). Solomon prayed, "You alone know the human heart" (2 Chron. 6:30), and the Hebrews writer said that God's word "judges the thought and attitudes of the heart" (Heb. 4:12 NIV).

Solomon advised us, "Above all else, guard your heart, for everything you do flows from it" (Prov. 4:23 NIV).
