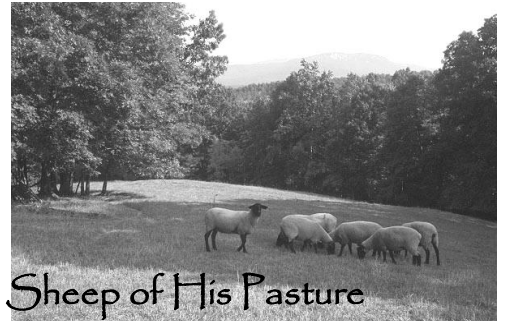

Evolution

There has been a great deal of controversy over the Texas State Board of Education's standards for science education in grades K-12. The standards adopted in 2009 called for students to "evaluate" scientific theories on origin and cellular complexity. In other words, teachers were allowed to teach evolution in a negative light. The board softened these standards on April 21. The new standards, which will go into effect during the 2018-19 school year, now call for students to "compare and contrast" the theories of origin and cellular complexity.

The Theory of Evolution amounts to an attempt to explain the diversity, similarity and complexity that exists in living organisms by natural means. For instance, the forelimbs of frogs, birds and humans are all similar. However, humans are much more complex beings than are frogs. Therefore, it is theorized that human beings evolved over long ages from frogs and other less complex creatures.

Many Christian people see no conflict between the Bible and evolution. They contend that evolution is simply the means that the Creator God used to bring about the creatures that he wills upon the earth. Those in this camp sometimes argue that Genesis 1-11 is composed of sacred myths which teach theological truths but are not intended to be taken at face value as history.

Jesus' own view would appear to be a major problem for those who would seek to harmonize the Bible with the theory of evolution. Jesus didn't view Genesis 1-2 as myth. He said, But at the beginning of creation God "made them male and female" (Mark 10:6 NIV). Some argue that Jesus was a man of his times and just didn't know any better. Others contend that Jesus did know better but chose to accommodate his teaching to the mistaken notion of his day. It would seem to me that either of these options would lead to some much greater problems than the one that they would hope to solve.

Christ wasn't an evolutionist, and, as a Christian, neither can I be one.
